

ORDINANCE NO. 3348

An Ordinance accepting a gift of five squirrel bridges from the Longview Sandbaggers.

WHEREAS, the Longview Sandbaggers civic organization has periodically constructed squirrel bridges and installed them over public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Longview Sandbaggers has offered to donate to the City of Longview a gift of five squirrel bridges suspended over the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Longview desires to accept the gift of such work of art, and to express its appreciation to the donor, artists, and craftsmen.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Longview do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the gift from the Longview Sandbaggers consisting of the following five bridges is hereby accepted by said City on behalf of the residents thereof with sincere and deep appreciation:

- Bruce Kamp Bridge: Built by Bill Kamp and friends; displayed at Squirreelfest in 2011; installed over Kessler Blvd near 1318 Kessler Blvd in 2011; estimated value \$2,000.
- John R. Dick Bridge: Built by John Dick and completed by J.H. Kelly; displayed at Squirreelfest in 2012; installed over Nichols Blvd near R.A. Long High School in 2013; estimated value \$2,000.
- OBEC “Woodie” Bridge: Built by OBEC of Vancouver; displayed at Squirreelfest in 2013; installed over Louisiana St near 1503 23rd in 2014; estimated value \$3,500.
- Safety Awareness Bridge: Built by the Bits and Bots Robotics Club of Mark Morris and R.A. Long High Schools; displayed at Squirreelfest in 2014; installed over Kessler Blvd near 1708 Kessler Blvd in 2015; estimated value \$2,500.
- R.D. Olson-Longview/Rainier Bridge: Built by R. D. Olson; displayed at Squirreelfest in 2015; installed over Kessler Blvd near 1024 Kessler in 2016; estimated value \$6,000.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty (30) days of its passage and publication as provided by law.
