SUBJECT: Draft Amended 2012 – 2017 TIP For February 9, 2012 Public Hearing

Attached for your review is a copy of the draft Amended 2012 – 2017 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (T.I.P.) for consideration by the City Council following the public hearing scheduled for the February 9, 2012 city council meeting. I've also attached a legend to assist with understanding the T.I.P. information.

State law requires that the City update its T.I.P. annually by June 30th, and file a copy of the adopted program with the Secretary of Transportation. In order to obtain federal transportation funding, a project must appear on the T.I.P. In addition, many state transportation funding programs require that projects be identified on the T.I.P. before they can be funded. After adoption, the T.I.P. can be subsequently amended by Council action after a public hearing, to include new projects and funding sources.

This proposed amended T.I.P. includes new grant-funded pedestrian improvement projects, new transit grants, and transit grants from prior years that were not completed. Projects added to the T.I.P. are:

- Priority 3: One Paratransit Mini-Bus; CTA 10-1; FTA Secured
- Priority 4: Two Expansion Transit Coaches; CTA 10-5; FTA Secured
- Priority 5: Two Paratransit Mini-Buses; CTA 11-1; FTA Secured
- Priority 6: Transit Operating Assistance; CTA 11-2; FTA Secured
- Priority 7: Three Biodiesel Coaches; CTA 12-1; FTA Secured
- Priority 8: Transit Operating Assistance; CTA 12-2; FTA Secured
- Priority 9: GPS/Intelligent Transportation System; CTA 12-3; FTA Secured
- Priority 10: Transit Maintenance Truck; CTA 12-4; FTA Secured
- Priority 11: Transit Supervisor Vehicle; CTA 12-5; FTA Secured
- Priority 12: 28th & Washington Way Pedestrian Crossing Improvements; WSDOT Secured
- Priority 13: 15th Ave Corridor Pedestrian Improvements; WSDOT Secured
- Priority 14: 15th Ave Bulb Outs and Pedestrian Signal Improvements; Proposed FHWA
- Priority 15: Washington Way & Hudson St Bulb Outs and Ped. Signal Impr.; Proposed FHWA
