Neighborhood Park Grant Program

Need

Lion's Den will be targeting at risk youth, single parent families, low income families, and recovering addicts from all walks of life. Our doors are open to anyone willing to dedicate their time and effort. Our target group can face many known day to day challenges. The Lion's Den can provide a safe, positive and energetic atmosphere with a change of pace and attitude to the daily struggles and an outlet for change for individuals and community. There is no cost to low income families and only a minimal cost to adults. We do it for the love of the sport and strive to make a positive impact on the Highlands community. In a boxing atmosphere a student must be open minded and willing to learn and coachable in order to make progress and reach goals. Students must make good decisions fast and think ahead. They learn to be respectful, responsible, and resourceful and have a respect for authority and follow rules. We coach members to apply these skills not only in the club but also at home, in the community, school and work.

Community Impact

We believe we can make a positive impact in the community by creating champions; bringing a spirit of hope and redemption to the Highlands. In addition to regular training, we bring special training camps with professionals, MMA and Boxing celebrity, CJ Peterson. Members will volunteer and participate in other outreach programs, like feeding the homeless and neighborhood cleanup, etc. Outdoor open sparring exhibitions are for Lion's Den members only, but open for viewing to the public. Our students will participate in bouts in our region to gain notoriety, giving the Highlands area something to be proud of by actively changing minds and hearts of youth by encouraging them to be great boxers. Our program provides family safe events in the highlands neighborhood. Lion's Den encourages kids to have a 2.0 or better grade point average showing progression in grades from the day they start training.

Access

The location of the Lion's Den boxing club at Archie Anderson park is in the heart of the Highland area with easy access to public bus routes and a safe walking distance from anywhere in the highlands area. Currently the program is open two days a week due to coaching and dependable volunteer staff availability. Our ultimate goal is being open five to seven days of week.

Financial Responsibility

Typically a high-quality boxing ring can last a lifetime. There will be ongoing maintenance costs associated with cleaning and maintaining the ring and space in general however the club will be incurring those specific costs. The club will also be responsible for purchasing all of the boxing program equipment to go along with the grant funded boxing ring.

Upon procurement of grants discussed in the funding section of this application, our group is prepared to order, clean, prepare and install the ring and all necessary equipment. Prior to receipt of the ring itself the volunteers will be preparing the floor and surrounding areas for installation of said ring and mats.

Cost Benefit

The benefits to Lion's Den Boxing Club are priceless just in the aspect of the cost for having exercise and getting kids into physical fitness. At \$55 a year as a registered member of USA Boxing and having a five to fifteen dollar donation fee a month (or based on a sliding scale), it is still the cheapest membership fee for this type of activity in the community currently. Community development and partnerships are one of our main mission goals, to network all our community resources together to help our at risk youth and give further guidance and opportunities to young adults and all the help they need to succeed in life. The lessons of self-respect, discipline and community up-building will give our youth the desire to respect our homes and our community members. The properties, homes, parks in the area will be improved by reducing crime rates, vandalism, reducing the need to join in gang activity and other crime related activities. Engaging our young people will free up much of the cities time, finances and other precious resources that could be used for so many other much needed help in our community up building. The more interaction our youth have with all other community partners, the more interested they become in wanting to join other groups and activities as well as the increased desire to play and work in our community grows with unstoppable excitement.

With these community partnerships we are showing the youth that all our groups and facilities are directly interested in their growth and development and want them to succeed.

Readiness to proceed

Immediately after approval we plan to begin preparing the club for current flooring (turf) removal, sweeping, cleaning, mopping, sealing the floor and applying the mats to the newly cleaned floor. In an 8 to 12 month period we plan to have the ring and mat flooring ready for use.

Funding

There are several sources for funding currently being secured.

1. A popcorn fundraiser is planned for July 2017 with the donation of popcorn in full secured. This effort is expected to raise between \$2500 to \$3500 in cash. All proceeds will go directly to this project as the popcorn, supplies and time will all be donated.
2. Weyerhaeuser Giving Fund grant will be applied for online by June 30, 2017. The application will ask for \$6,000 in total.
3. Burlington Northern Foundation – The grant application process has been started and BNSF has no limit on the amount for which we can apply. However, generally, the grants fall within the \$1,000.00 to \$10,000.00 range.
4. Volunteer Hours (80 hours of work) for building the ring, preparing equipment, cleaning, painting, prepping the floors, etc. Volunteers secured.

Additionally, future grants, donations, fund-raisers and partnerships including HNA community center for tutoring classes, computer classes showing films and practice footage. HNA community service projects: community garden to help give guidance for healthy eating and wellness and living. LPD partnership is an agreement to help work with our at risk youth and give a good positive place to express their energy and give them positive role models to learn from and be mentored by.
