

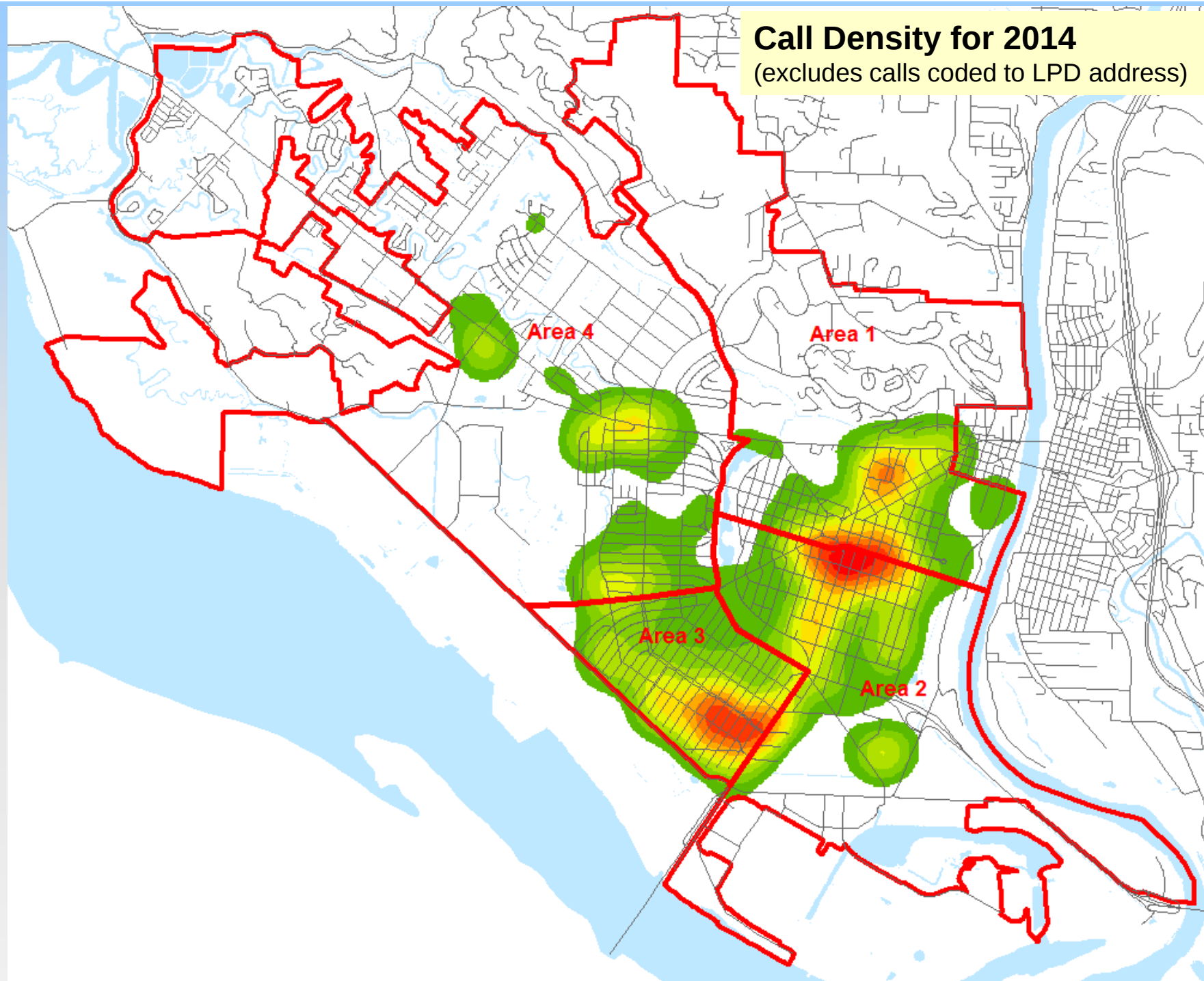

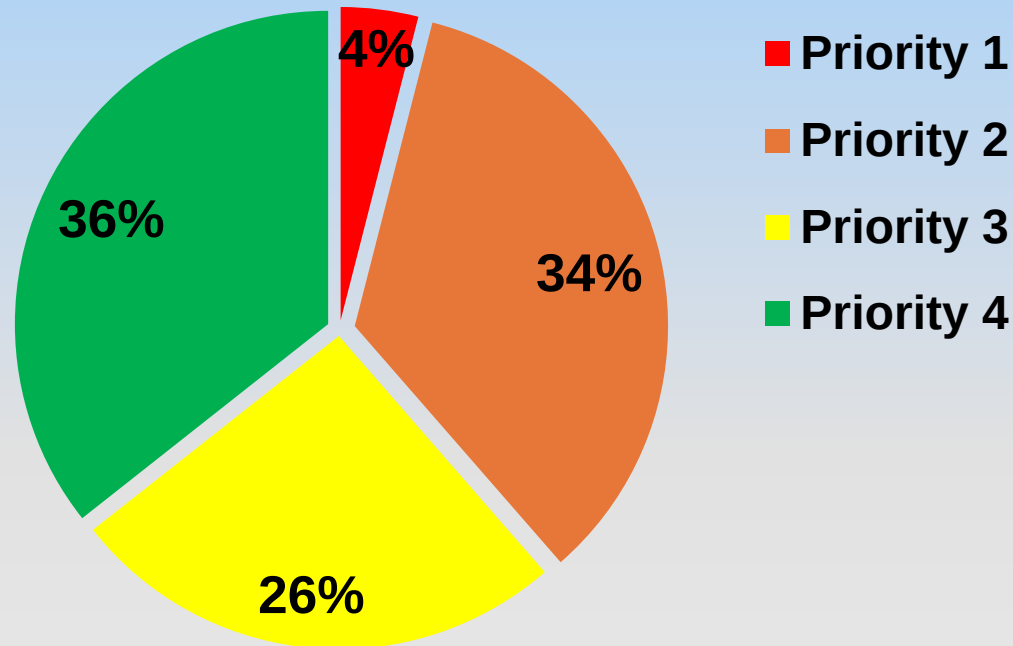


Call Density for 2014

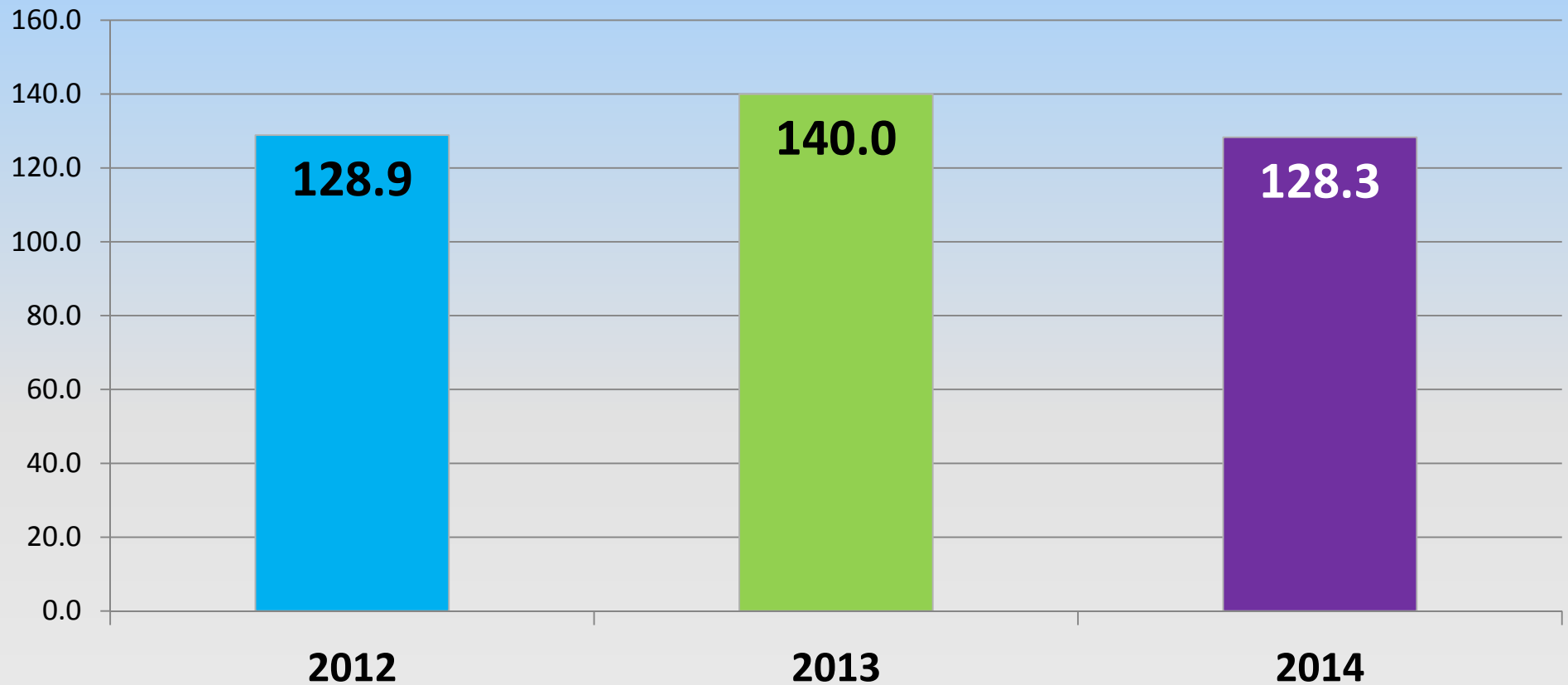

- Vandalism -22%
- Domestic violence -15%
- DUI arrests +35%
- Calls for service +28%
- Drug offenses +13%
- Weapons Offenses -53%

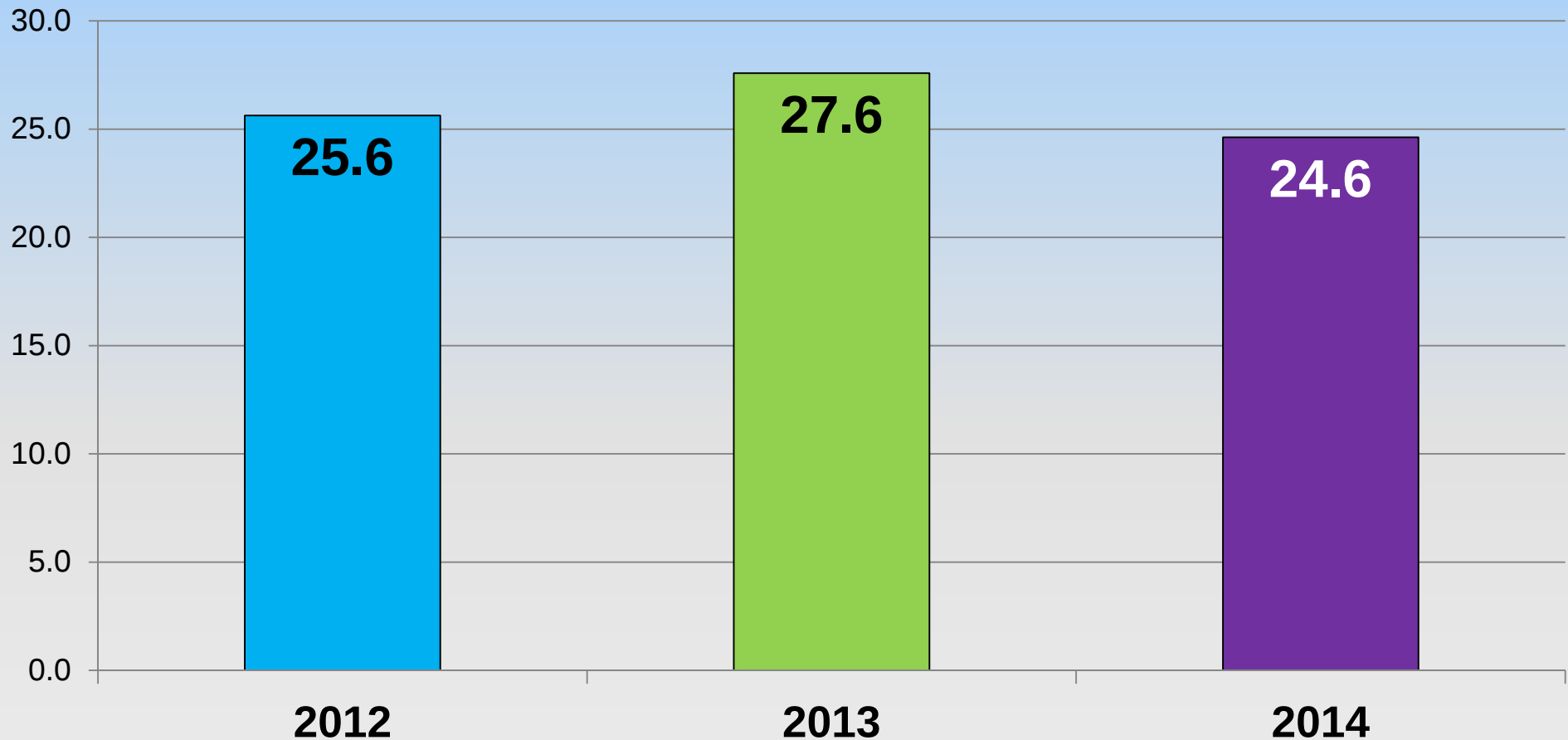
Longview Group A Offense Rate per 1000 population

Group A Offenses include categories of **Persons**, **Property** and **Society** crimes

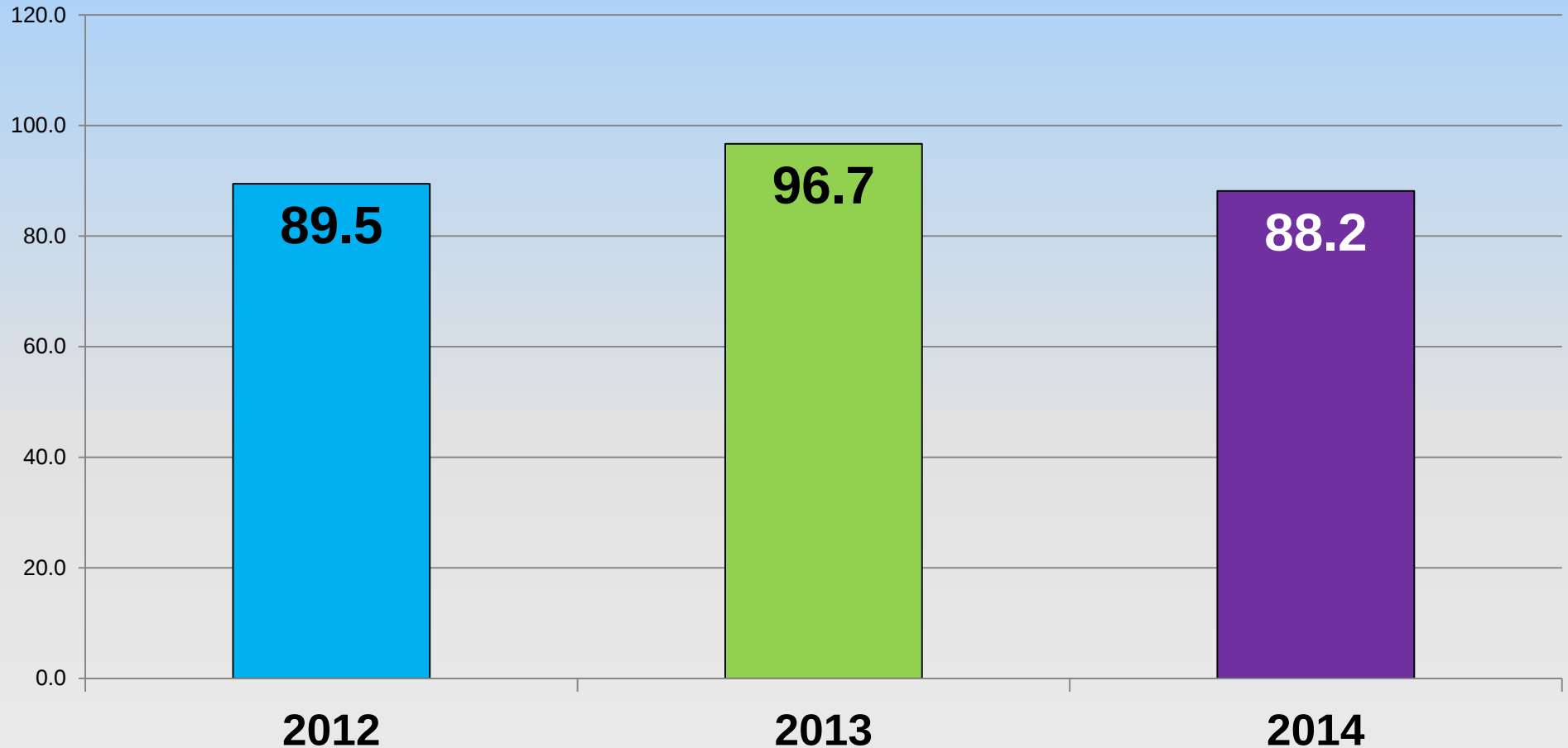
Longview Group A *Persons* Crime Rate per 1000 population

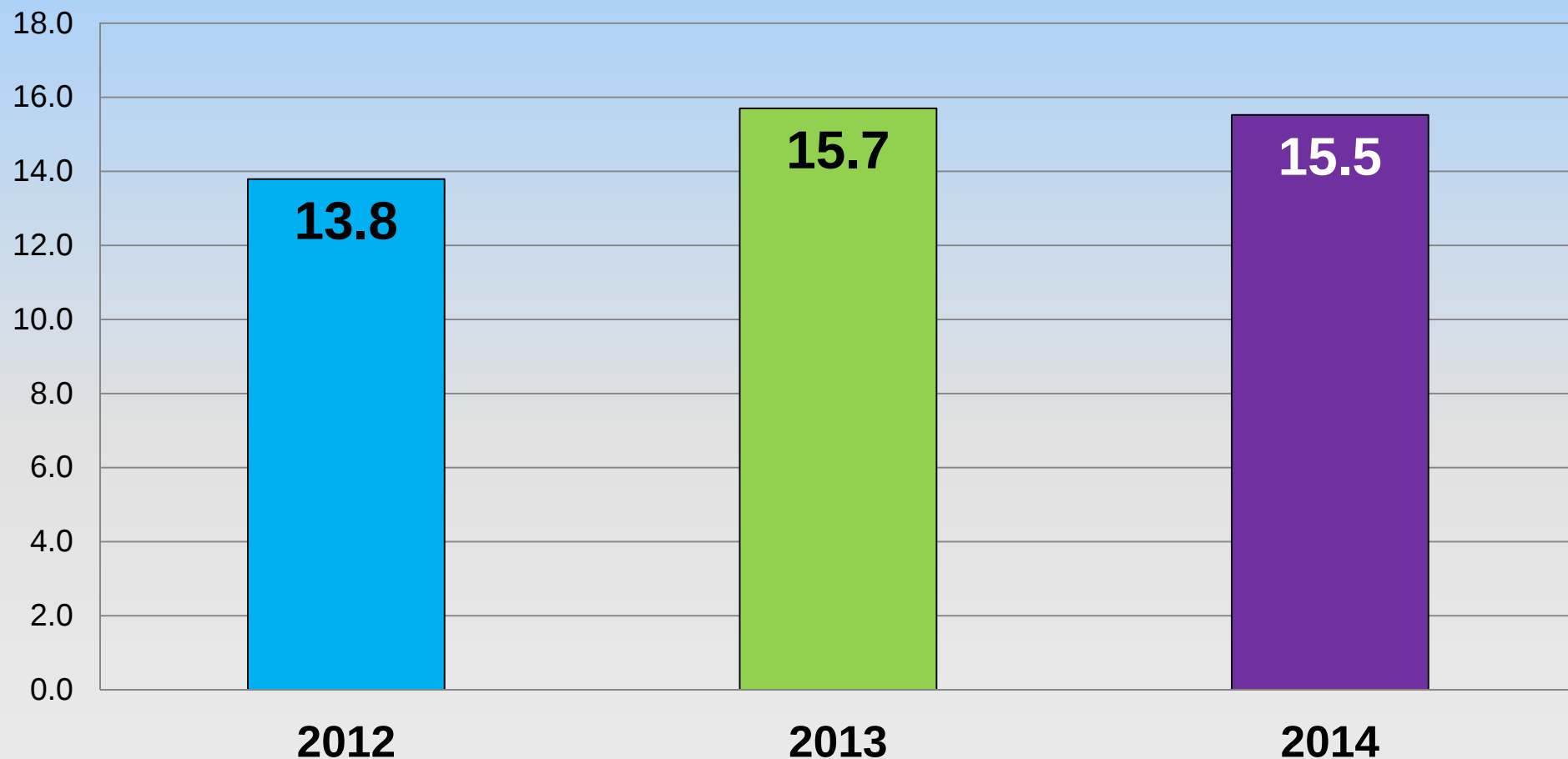
Longview Group A *Property* Crime Rate per 1000 population

Longview Group A *Society* Crime Rate per 1000 population

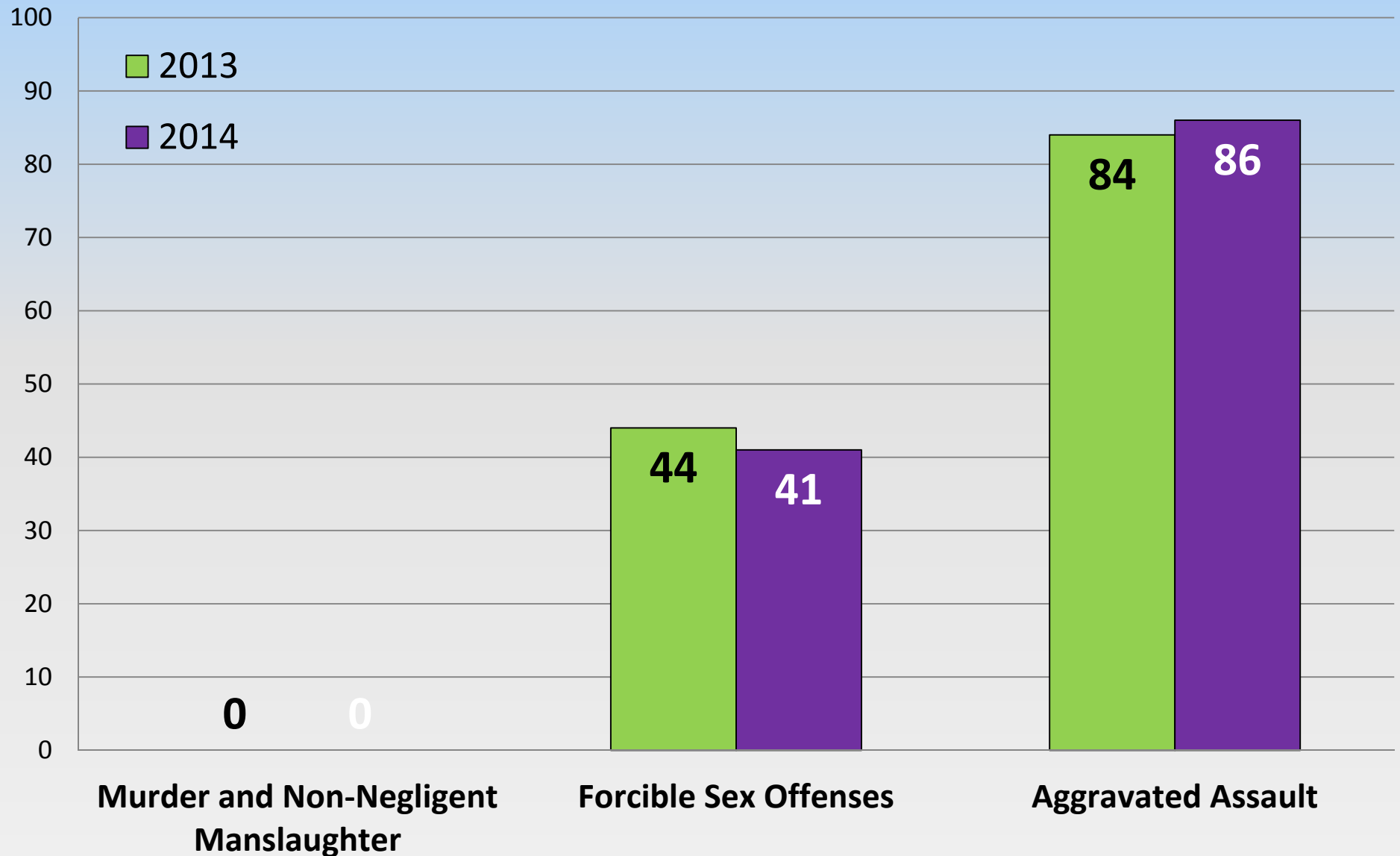


Crimes against Society rate is down 1% from 2013

NIBRS Group A Society offenses include Drug offenses, Pornography, Gambling, Prostitution, and Weapon violations. (complete list)

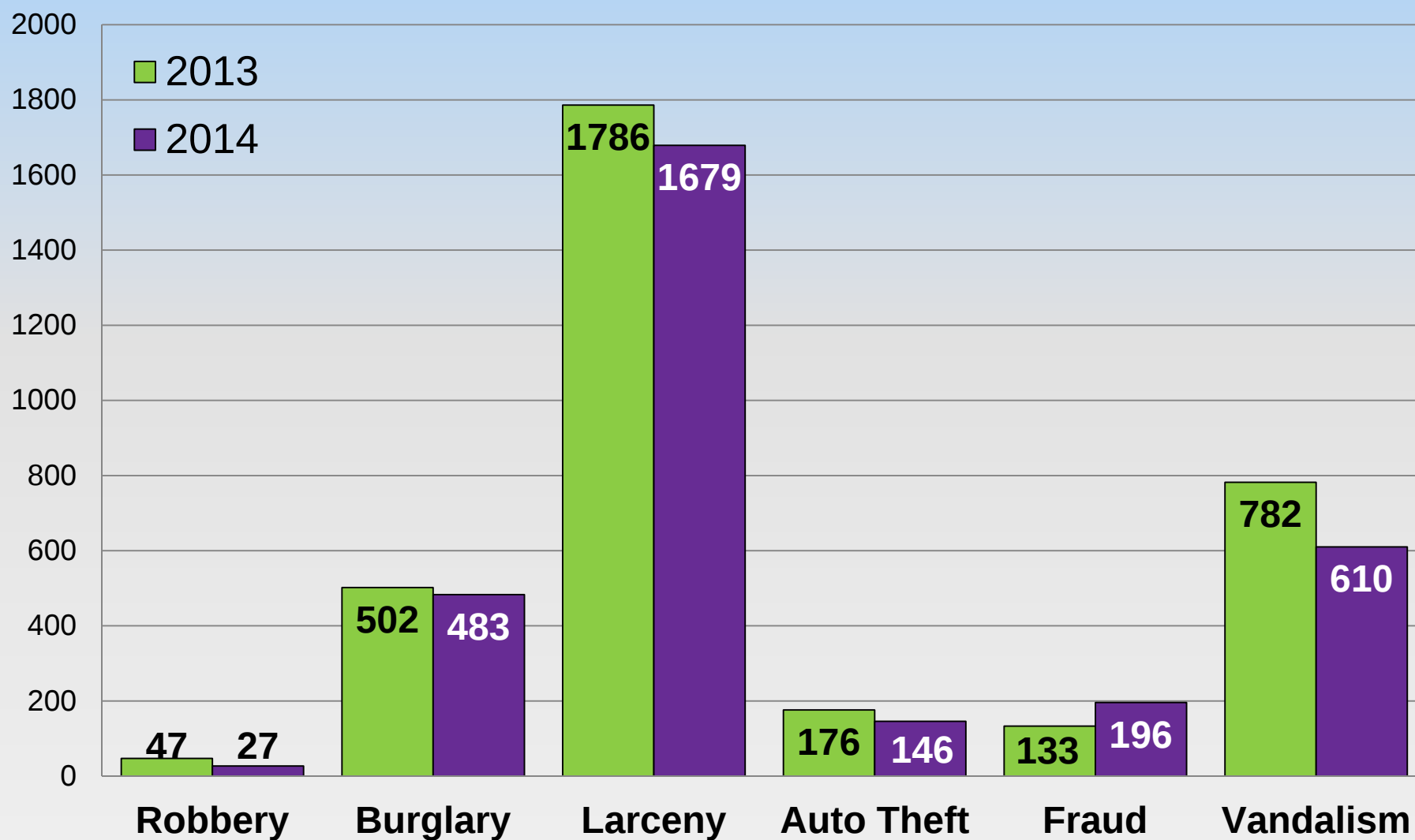

Actual number of *Persons* Crimes



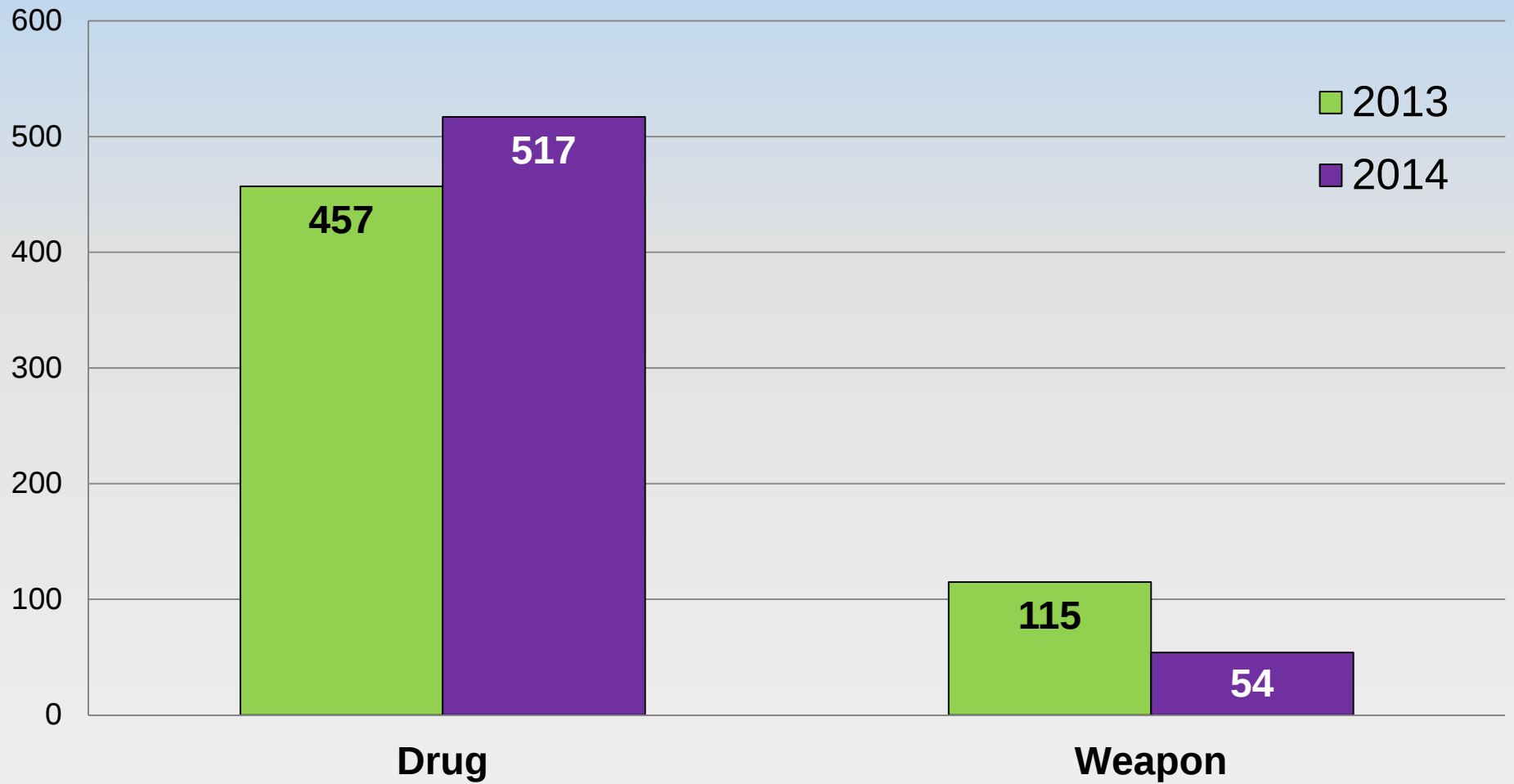

Actual number of *Property* Crimes

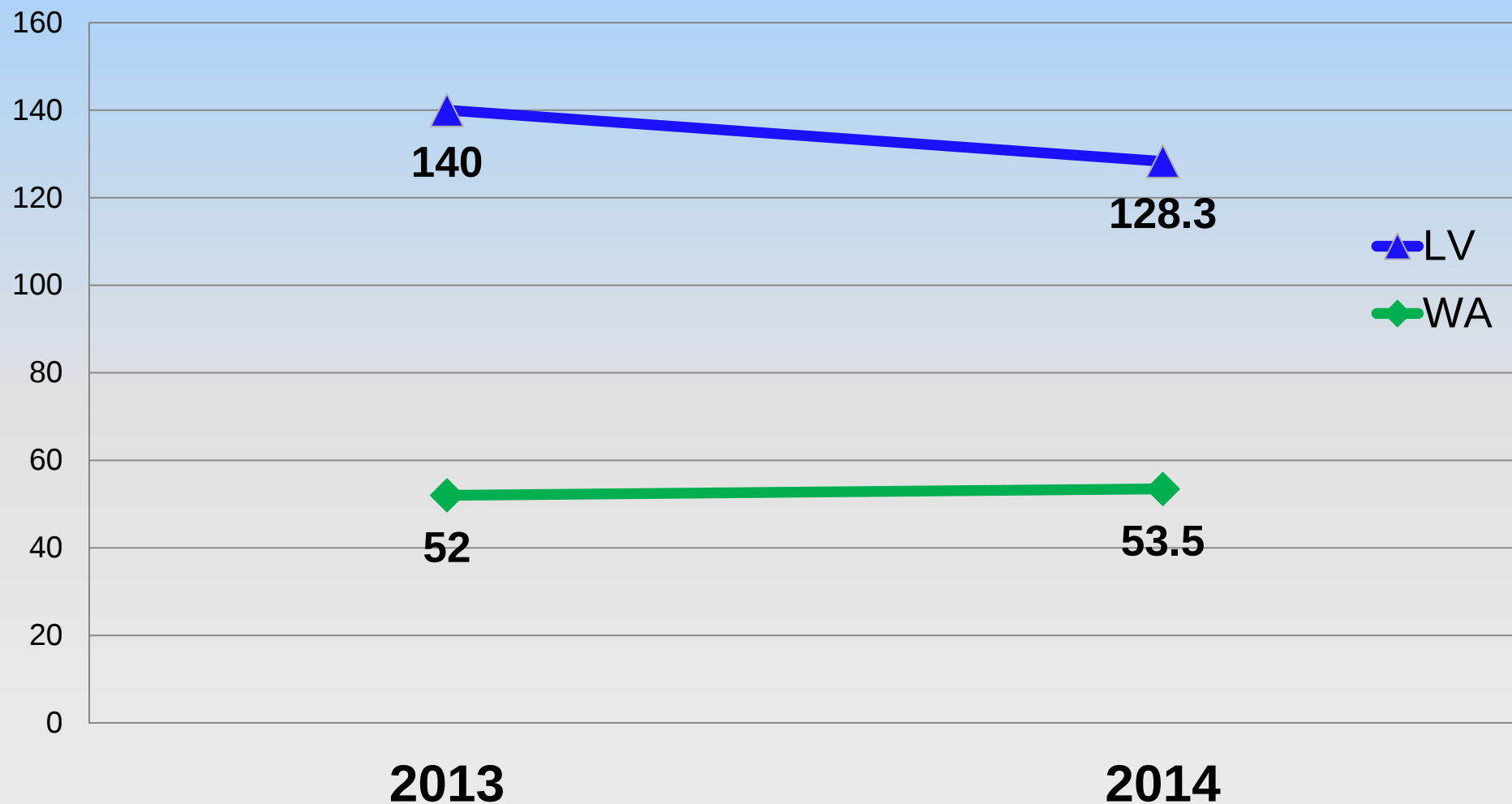

Actual number of *Society* Crimes

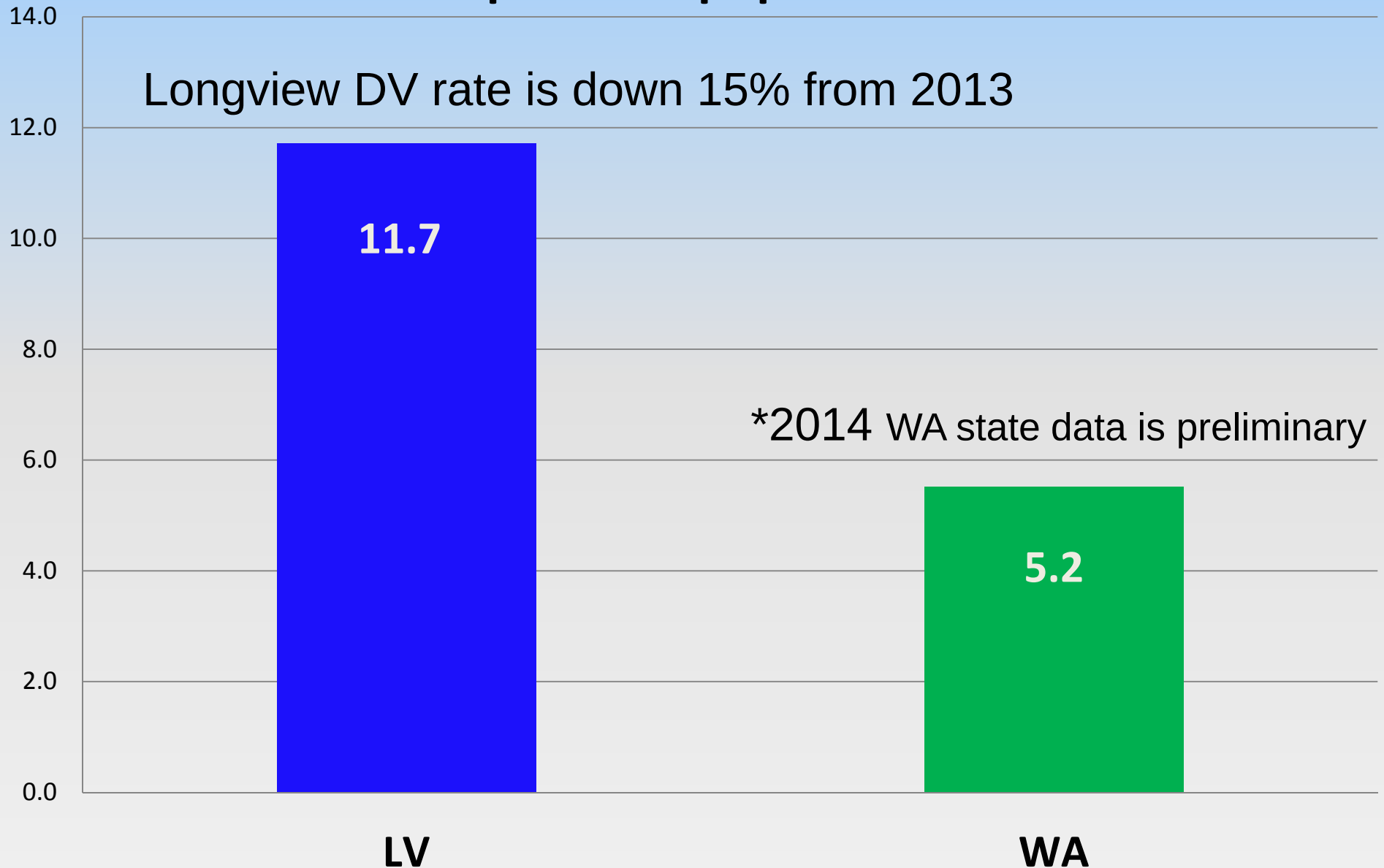


LV vs WA Group A Crime Rate per 1000 population

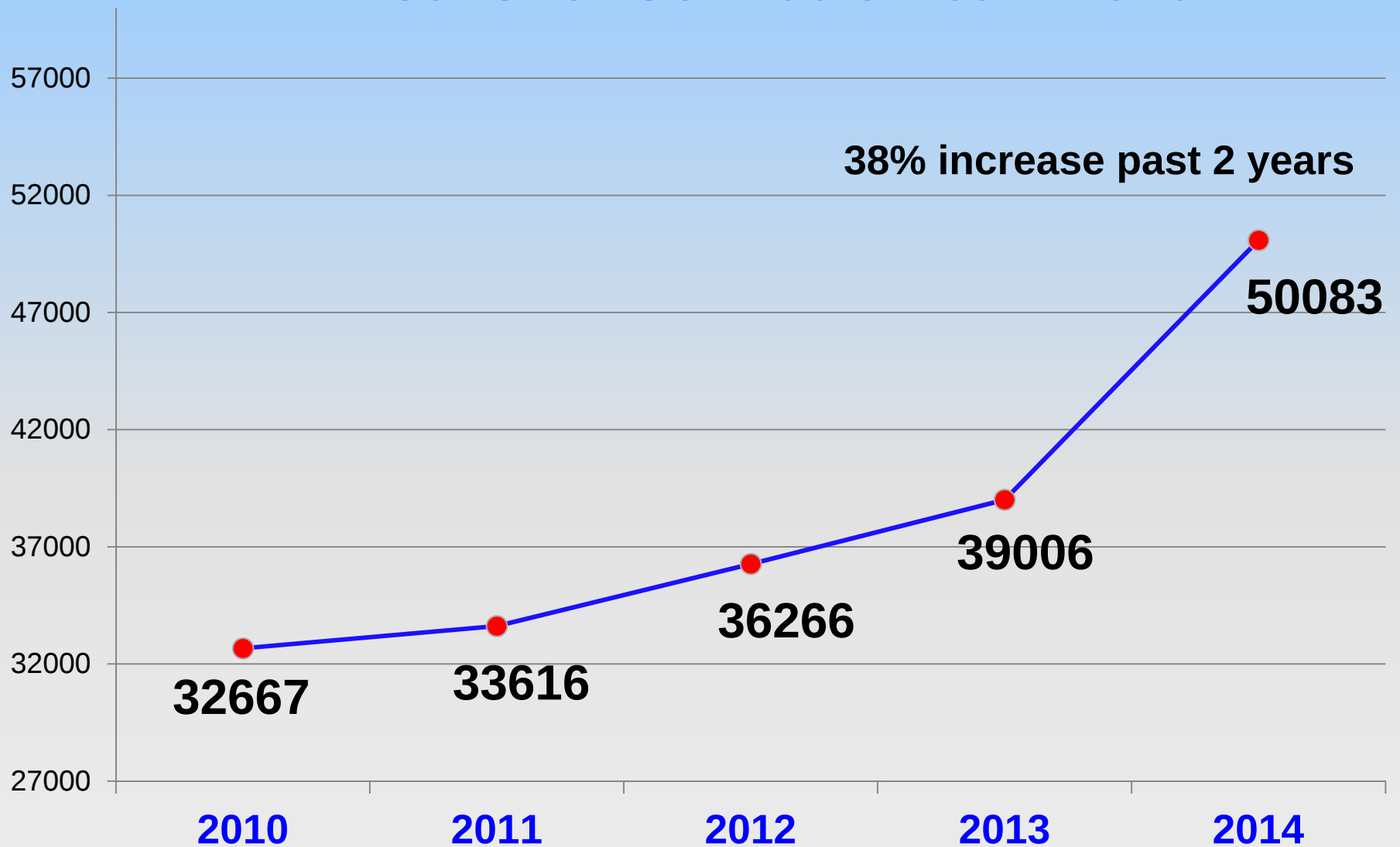

Domestic Violence Rates per 1000 population



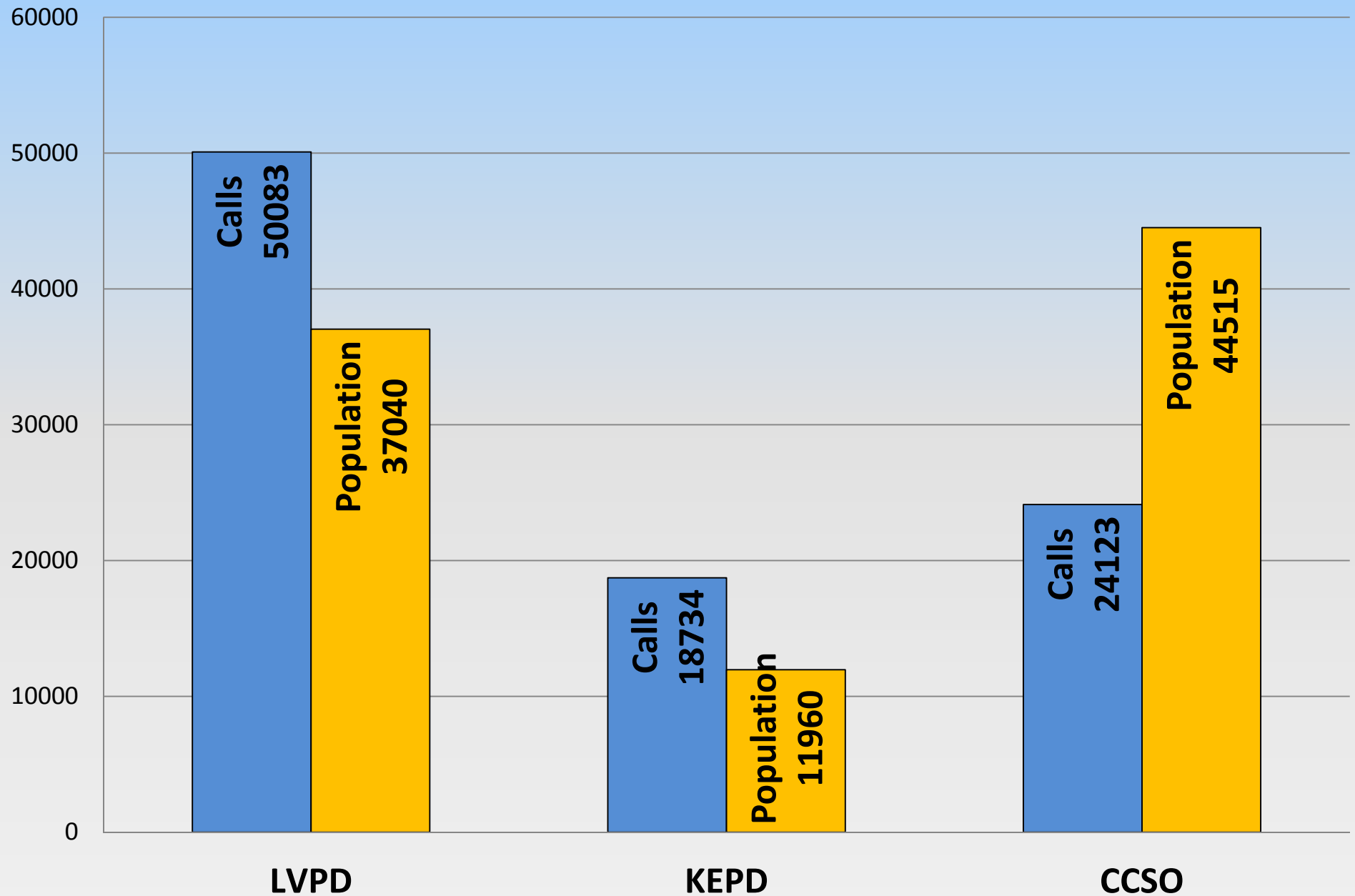
LPD Calls for Service 5 Year Trend



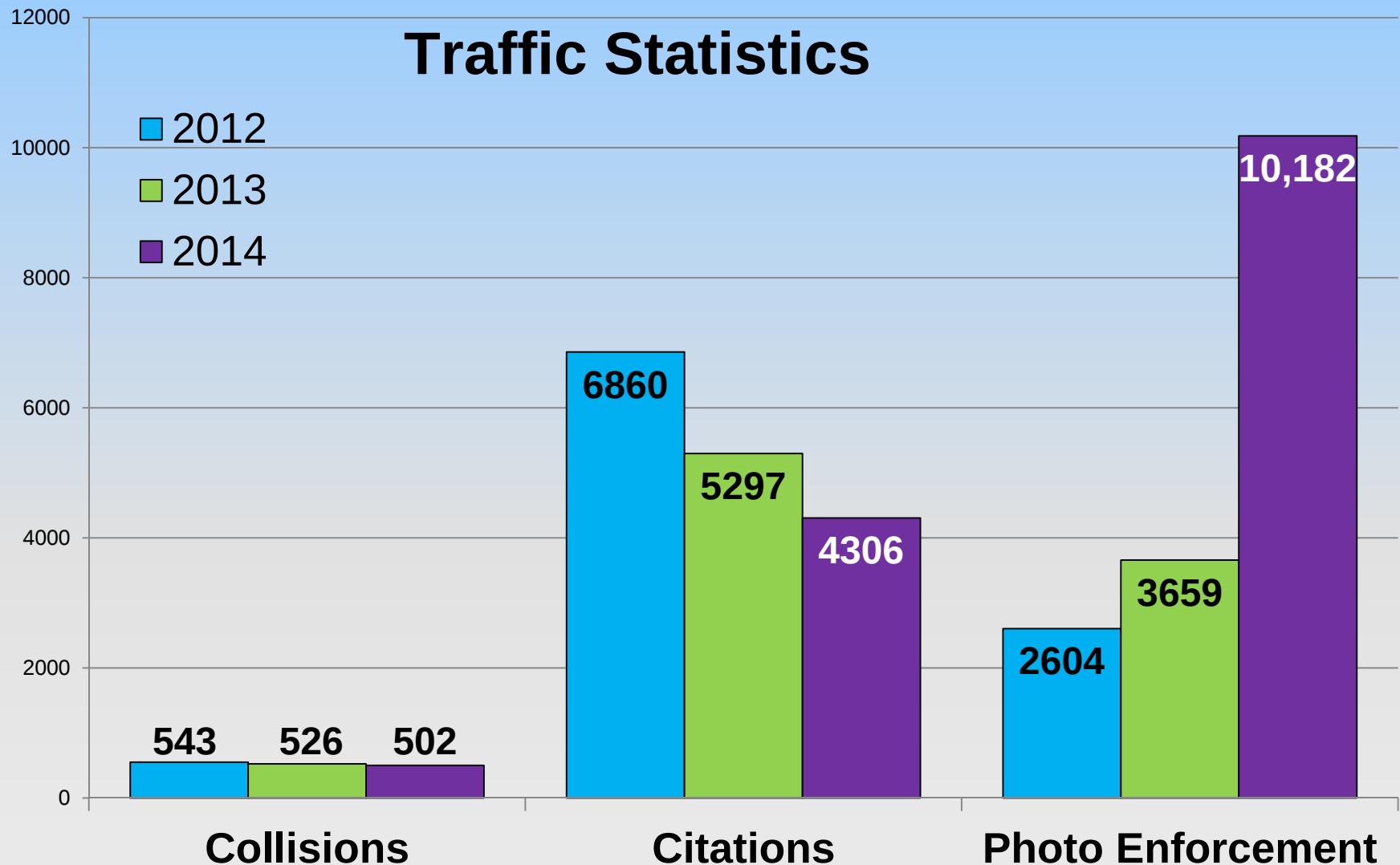
Calls for service are up 53% from 2010 to 2014

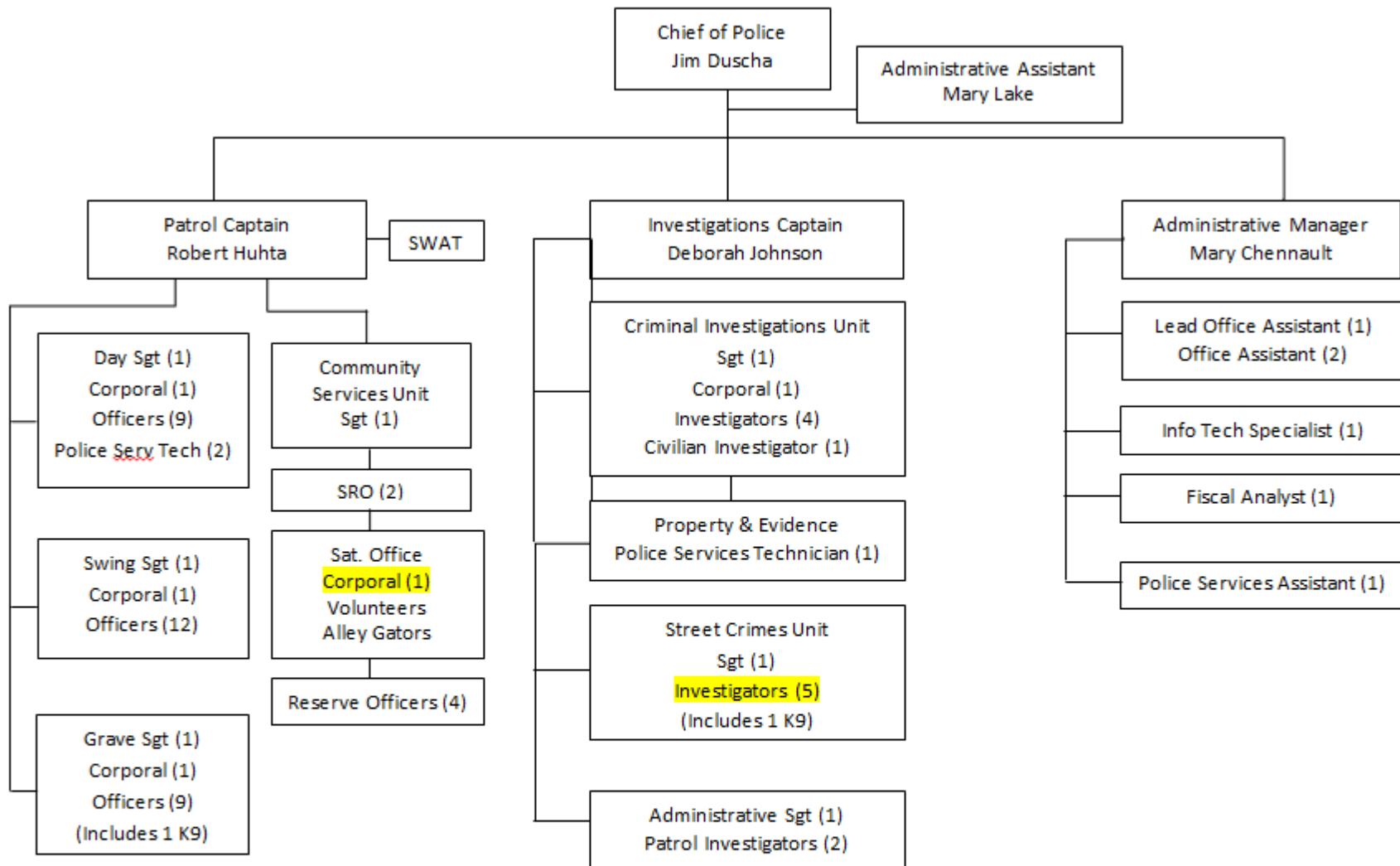
2014 Calls vs Population

SCU has 1 new position and 1 transfer from the CWNTF

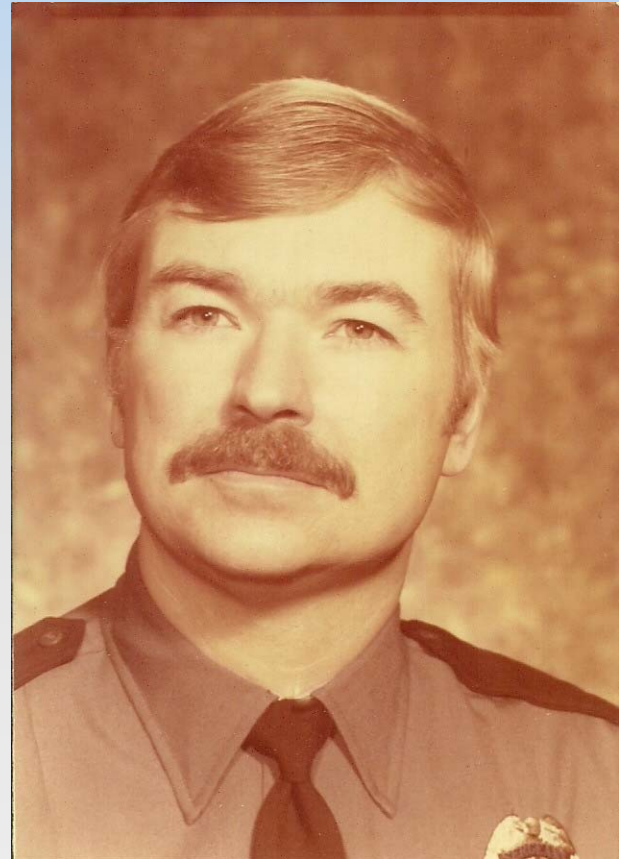
