
A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, in the 2017 Work Plan Initiatives of City Council, the Human Resources Department is tasked with addressing an actionable item under the area of Addressing Quality of Place Issues; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to complete an Americans with Disabilities Act self-assessment and transition plan that addresses access to services, activities, buildings, and right-of-ways within the City of Longview; and

WHEREAS, establishment of a City Accessibility Advisory Committee will be integral in the success of this initiative and addressing one of the deliverable tasks in this strategy; and

WHEREAS, the City of Longview wishes to establish a committee to provide review and guidance to staff on Department of Justice requirements and general regulatory compliance as identified in the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990; assist the City, and its staff, on accessibility determinations to current services, activities, buildings, and right-of-ways; assist the city, and its staff, in reviewing and advising on the prioritization of projects to improve City buildings, infrastructure, right-of-ways, parking, and new development accessibility; and assist the City, and its staff, in reviewing and advising on the prioritization of means to improve accessibility to City provided services and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Longview as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created a nine (9) member Accessibility Advisory Committee, whose membership and operation shall be as set for in the attached charter.
