SUBJECT: Proposed Veteran's Memorials at RA Long Park

At the November 23, 2015 regular meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission, a proposal to install two new markers for veterans at RA Long Park was approved. If fundraising is successful, the proposed markers will be installed on either side of the existing veteran's memorial at slight angles following the existing curve of the concrete surface.

The proposal is brought by Bill Kasch, a member of the Historic Preservation Commission. His idea is to install stone marker similar to memorials found in other cities which list the names of American service men and women killed in action who came from the community. The Historic preservation Commission acted on the application after seeing that the Parks Advisory Board had approved the proposal and location for the markers. The HPC was primarily concerned with review for compatibility with the park and future plans for the park. As a new addition, the proposal is considered for its potential impacts to the historic setting of the park. The commission members ultimately determined the proposed markers have been designed to complement the existing veteran's memorial maker on the site which is proposed to remain after the planned renovations to the park are complete. The Commission did not question or verify the content of the markers which list the war, branch of service and names of individual veterans. The methodology and accuracy of this information is contingent upon Mr. Kasch's research which relies upon a list of names published by The Daily News.

Funding for the markers has not been secured and it is Mr. Kasch's intention to approach the City government for a contribution to help complete the project. Other groups including associations of veterans and local industry will be approached as well. The City Council will need to consider whether to fund this project.

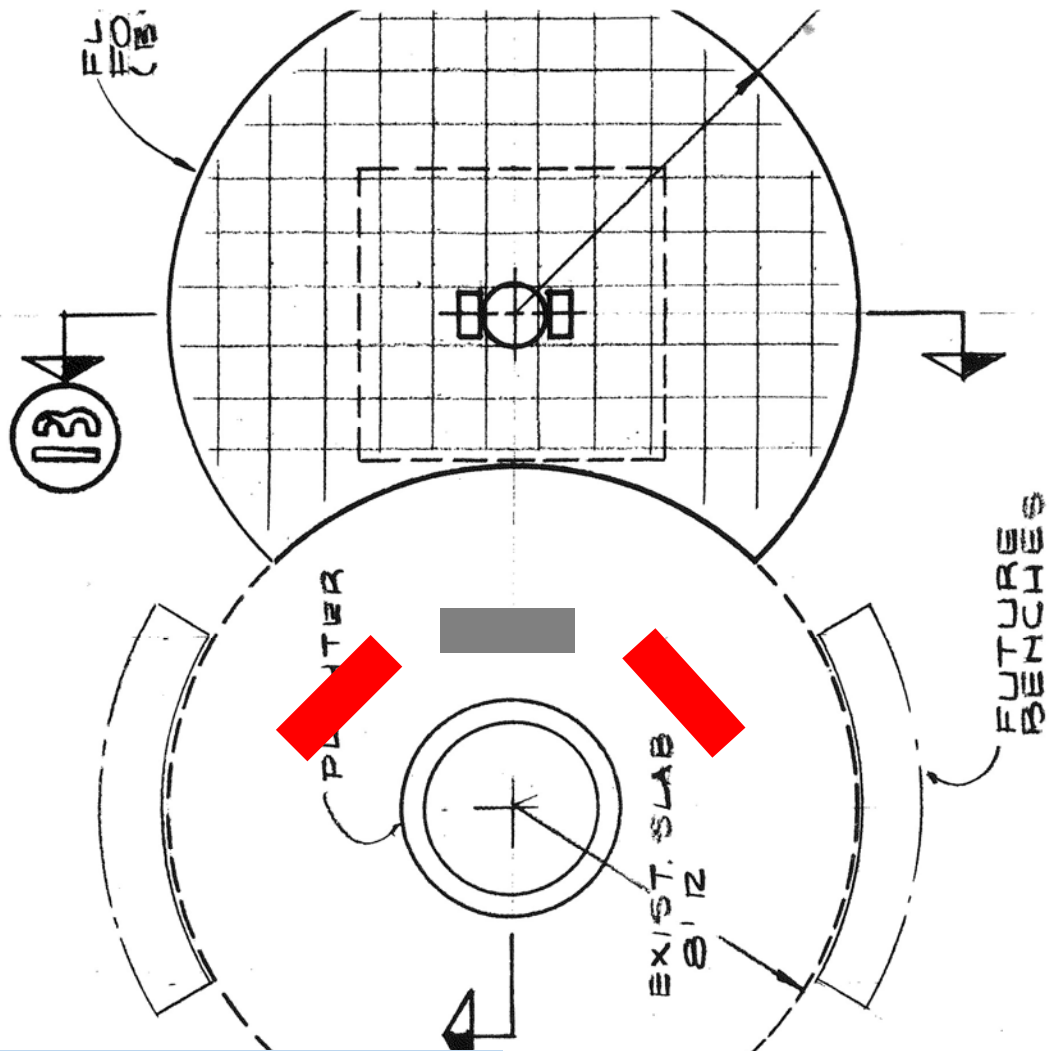

Close up of the existing monument and bulb shaped concrete slab. The new monuments will be situated on either side of the existing monument.
