

Resolution No. 2289

A RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR A PROPOSAL TO VACATE A SECTION OF EXCESS RIGHT-OF-WAY SOUTH OF 7TH AVENUE & WEST OF CALIFORNIA WAY

WHEREAS, the City of Longview has received a request from the property owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the excess right-of-way sought to be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Longview as follows:

Section 1. City Council, pursuant to RCW 35.79.010, hereby initiates procedures to vacate excess right-of-way located between Lot 8 and Lot 9 in Assessor's Plat No. 5, Volume 8 of Plats, Page 26, records of the Auditor, Cowlitz County, Washington, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the public right-of-way shown on said Assessor's Plat No.5 lying southerly of Lot 8, northerly of Lot 9; westerly of the California Way right-of-way and easterly of the abandoned railroad right-of-way quit claim deeded to the City of Longview by International Paper Company under Assessor's File No. 3598396.

The described excess right-of-way was dedicated to the City of Longview on September 4, 1944 by Long-Bell Timber Company for highway purposes under Assessor's File No. 252281

Section 2. Thursday, February 28, 2019, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers in City Hall, 1525 Broadway, Longview, Washington, is fixed as the time and place for the hearing on said proposed excess unimproved right-of-way vacation.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall give notice of the pendency of said proposal and time and place of hearing, as required by RCW 35.79.020.
