Service Targets:

- Not sure what that might include; not aware of a major employer who might be prepared to commit to welfare-to-work unless that would be CAP, or some other social service agency.

Project Targets:

- Would ask community groups, agencies for suggestions of worthy projects for consideration
- Downtown building re-development of space to insure utilization of under-used spaced (i.e. new rest equipment)
- Façade improvement
- Sidewalks / streetscapes (curb cuts)
- Off street parking where needed
- Water/sewer for aging pipes
- I think the street lights and sidewalks are critical to changing the culture of Highlands' neighborhood
- Highlands lighting
- Road repair city-wide
- Sidewalk development in CVG/Mint Valley
- Street lights in Highlands
- Sidewalk repair/development Highlands

Population Targets:

- Assistance for housing for large families

Service Targets:

- Family self-sufficiency
- Would like to encourage owner participation, either financial or through labor on the project, as a part of any program we might fund
- Housing for family self-sufficiency
- Long-term housing for families exiting women's support shelter

Projects Targets:

- Perhaps aiding development in the area of NW 2nd/3rd N. of Cowlitz Way could result in construction of affordable housing stock
- Improve neighborhood livability
- Mental health outreach
