This is a request to replace the playground play events that have been vandalized beyond repair. Most events have been removed from the areas due to safety issues. Some of the vandalized components are part of larger structures that do not allow for removal unless the entire portion of the playground would be removed.

Recommend that entire Gearhart playground be removed and replaced with swing set. Two slides and a walk bridge have been vandalized and not replaced due to unavailability of parts.

Many of the City of Longview playgrounds are in need of replacement play events. The oldest existing playground was installed in 1990. Many have experienced vandalism along with wear and age. In most cases, the entire play event must be removed to comply with safety standards.

Many of the parks are situated in low to moderate-income neighborhoods and are all well used during all seasons of the year.

All age groups benefit from a safe and well-maintained park and playground. They encourage getting outside and exercising versus the television and video games. The outdoors and park settings promote this active and healthy lifestyle and foster social growth.

Park areas and the playgrounds within them are open to the public from dawn to dusk year round.

The benefits of completing this project for our citizens will be improved physical and mental health, social relationships, and neighborhood pride.

This project addresses the City Council's Preserve Neighborhoods and Address Quality of Place Initiatives in that it will enhance parks and green spaces; create access to recreation areas that are currently insufficient; and improve the appearance and quality of life in the areas.

If approved the Parks Department could proceed immediately. There are no permits required and requesting updated quotes from the vendors could easily be initiated.

The labor to install the parts would be from City of Longview Parks department employees. Certified Playground Safety Inspectors are on staff. Concrete for the footings would be purchased from operating budget.
