\& Over 250 kids (young and old) participated in Mud Day at Roy Morse. DeRosier Trucking brought in 60 tons of top soil and the Fire Department sprayed 2,250 gallons of water over the top to make the mud. Participants were able to play in 3 cardboard tunnels, a mud kitchen, an art area for easel painting, hula hoops, and stomped in tires. Special thanks to our Parks division who smoothed out the top soil mounds.
\& 122 of the 125 Community Gardens on $32^{\text {nd }}$ Ave have been rented for the season.

* Summer Meals program at Northlake, Olympic schools and Archie Anderson and Elks Building park have served 288 breakfasts (Olympic and Northlake only) 789 lunches (all sites) and 260 snacks (Archie Anderson and Elks only). The week of June 29 Central Kitchen at Longview school district was closed for the holiday. Panini's \& More and Arby's generously donated a total of 320 lunches to provide meals that week.
