## **PARKS BOARD REPORT**

- 23 hours of vandalism repair
- Asian island entry gates destroyed
- Multiple damage to locks at Hemlock RR's dead bolts
- Security Company has reported more than any previous period
- Continued with lake Sacajawea flushing
- Mow route has reduced due to dry weather
- Mt Solo trail work completed
- Park usage is very high and thus garbage continues to be heavy
- Very dry conditions are stressing plant material at all Parks
- Irrigation at Lake Sacajawea continues
- Go 4<sup>th</sup> turf recovery has been very good
- Irrigation continues at all locations with controllers
- Continue 6 days per week softball field preparation
- Pressure washed shelter areas at Lake
- Re painted rest rooms at 17<sup>th</sup> and Nichols
- Added path rock to paths at Lake
- Regency Park, 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, nursery and Mint Farm rough mowed
- Painted Pickle ball lines on tennis courts at John Null and Vandercook
- Continued with post emergent weed control in dry turf areas
- Large number of wasp and bee calls
- Fruit control on plum trees was not effective in many areas
