- Mowing routes have decreased significantly
- Leaf mulching throughout Parks via mowing has begun and is heavy
- Vandalism costs of \$2435 for this period
- 17<sup>th</sup> Nichols rest room lights destroyed
- Rains have made softball field preparation tough for late fall leagues
- Hanging baskets removed from Commerce

- Commerce irrigation winterized
- Park use has slowed and will be on 4 day week service schedule 10-17-16
- Tennant Way planters inspected and replant list given to contractor
- Asian Island prepared for Sister City visit in 2 weeks
- First application of algae control had very good result
- Fall post emerge weed control finished
- Playground, benches, trash cans pressure washing has been completed
- Set up and removed canopy for events at Golf course
- Repaired fences that had been damaged at Asian island and Rhododendron bed
- Painted all rest rooms that were in use for season, floors also
- Painted under side of Louisiana bridge
- Installed lights on Washington Way bridge for Domestic violence month
