- Summary of comments received:
 - North of Hudson Street
 - Allow for personal service land uses & define personal services
 - Difficulty of developing on river shoreline
 - Need to increase allowed density for multi-family residential development
 - Need to create more public access to shoreline (e.g. Dike trail)
 - Traffic problems especially at Hudson Avenue/3rd Avenue intersection

- 1st and 3rd Avenue Corridor open house
- Summary of comments received (continued)
 - South of Hudson Street
 - Need to allow an emergency shelter on 3rd Avenue
 - Need to keep industrial land for industrial uses
 - Need to have more flexibility in what land uses are allowed
 - Need to exclude all residential-type uses and activities not expressly related to light industry

- Next Steps for Planning Commission

 - Review goals, objectives and policies thru February
 - Discuss future land use map changes starting in February
 - Hold public hearing(s) Late Spring 2017
 - Recommendation to Council by June 30, 2017
