 limited to, the authority to hire employees, staff, and services, to enter into
 contracts, to acquire, hold, and dispose of real and personal property, and to sue and
 be sued.
- To carry out the purposes of RCW 36.73, and subject to the provisions of RCW 36.73.065, to impose the following taxes, fees, charges, and tolls, as and when deemed appropriate:
 - o (a) A sales and use tax in accordance with RCW 82.14.0455;
 - o (b) A vehicle fee in accordance with RCW 82.80.140;
 - (c) A building or development fee or charge in accordance with RCW 36.73.120.
