PC 2015-8UPDATE ON THE PROCESS TO DEVELOP ZONING1/18/17REGULATIONS FOR EMERGENCY SHELTERS

The Ad Hoc committee on the process to develop zoning reglations for emergency shelters has met several times. Discussion points include:

* SPU permit for shelters

* Proper zoning districts - office/commercial, general commercial, R4 district, mixed use commercial/industrial

- * Buffers 500 ft., 1500 ft., distance from residential districts, parks, schools
- * Transportation
- * Small shelters for special populations
- * Congregate care vs. group home
- * Concerns with low barrier shelters
