NEED: The community park is underused and under decay. This project is needed because it measurably increases use in the park. Our goal is to build an indoor fitness facility, do locker rooms, and build a stadium; there are no other similar facilities in the area. Immediately, having goalposts, a scoreboard and the ability to mark out a football field is unique in the highlands. It will provide semi permanent football & soccer goalposts for multi-purpose use

COMMUNITY IMPACT: the highlands directly will benefit, as well as the Cobras. Kids of all ages can watch and participate with our various programs, like heads up tackling, camps, cheer camps, and bringing LCYF to the highlands from west Longview; the ages impacted are kids thru adults who also participate

ACCESS: we are somewhat limited by field conditions and current facilities at the moment, but we envision 8-10 months of annual activity once this is off the ground

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY: the lifespan of the project is indefinite as there are always going to be kids and men to mentor to be community champions. Practically, a turf field is preferable because there is 80% more annual use potential. Estimated costs to maintain the artificial turf are under \$100,000 a year, to be covered by fees and usage costs, as well as other fundraising efforts. Costs of operation for an indoor training facility would need to be explored for more information

COST BENEFIT: we believe the benefit far outweighs the cost, as we increase park use, provide provides that build confidence and hope in youth in their futures, giving the community something to be proud of (this is our team! This is our park!); the potential economic impact is as follows:

READINESS TO PROCEED: a financial match is possible within 45 days; permitting is an unknown at this time; there are several volunteers set to assist this project

FUNDING: public, private, and sponsorship; networking for partnerships is the work of the executive director. Red Leaf as indicated a desire to assist; my grandpa has some funds available for me; i have some money in savings to help start things as well.


