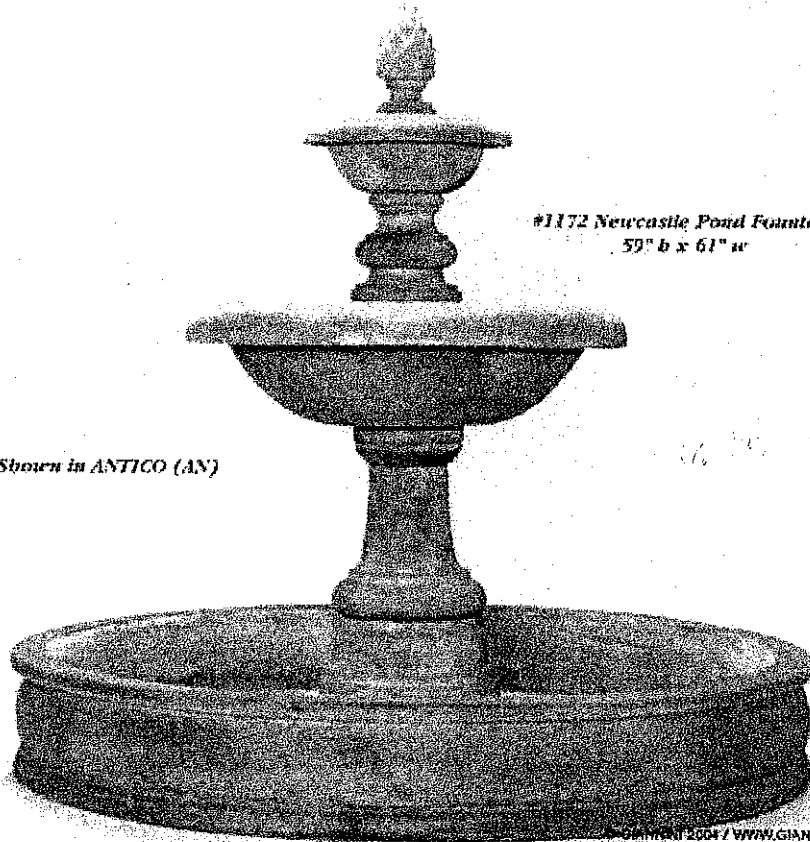


DWSNA FOUNTAIN PROJECT
