A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING FOR COLLECTION OF FEES ASSESSED BY THE LONGVIEW TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, chapter 39.34 RCW (the Interlocal Cooperation Act) allows local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate on the basis of mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 3334, the City established the Longview Transportation Benefit District (TBD) and authorized funding for any purpose allowed by law, including but not limited to, the operation of the District and to make transportation improvements consistent with existing state, regional and local transportation plans and necessitated by existing or reasonably foreseeable congestion levels pursuant to chapter 36.73 RCW; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2017, the TBD and the City entered into an interlocal agreement for the City to provide administrative and technical support services for the TBD; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2017, the TBD approved Ordinance No. TBD 17-01 establishing a \$20.00 vehicle license fee within the boundary of the TBD, such fee to be collected by the Department of Licensing; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2017, the City Council approved Ordinance No. 3341 providing for the City to assume the TBD and all of its rights, powers, functions, immunities, and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Department of Licensing (DOL) desire to enter inter an interlocal agreement, as allowed by RCW 39.34, to provide for the DOL to collect vehicle license fees assessed by the TBD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Longview as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement with the Washington State Department of Licensing for collection of

fees assessed by the Longview Transportation Benefit District, which is
attached as Exhibit A, and forming a part of this Resolution.
