Minutes of the ad hoc committee on homeless shelters

Meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM

Present were City Council members Scott Vydra and Steve Moon and Planning Commission members Ramona Leber and Christine Schott.

Staff present included Planning Manager Steve Langdon, Community Development Director John Brickey and City Attorney James McNamara

Minutes of prior meeting were moved for approval, motion was seconded and approved by voice vote

- Steve Langdon presented the contents of the present discussion draft, which now shows the combined language for the commercial and R-4 zones.
- Public comment was invited and taken.
- Following public comment and in response to it, clarifying language was added to the use of non-prescribed medicine in residential district homeless shelter group homes, and the proposed maximum age of youths in homeless shelter group homes that serve only youth was changed to "youth who have not yet reached the age of 20"
- The Committee addressed the next step which is to hold a public meeting at which those owning property or residing near the zones to be affected by the proposal, as well as the public at large, can comment on the draft.
- Next meeting will take place either on May 10 or 24<sup>th</sup>, depending on how soon affected citizens
  can be sent notice and on locating a suitable meeting location to accommodate the large
  number of people expected to attend
