- Rains have made softball field preparation impossible

- First application of moss control had very good result
- Spring pre emerge weed control finished
- Playground, benches, trash cans pressure washing has started
- Set up and removed canopy at Lake for 24 hour walk event
- Repaired fences that had been damaged at Roy Morse
- Painted all rest room walls and floors at Elks memorial
