A RESOLUTION OF THE CITIZENS' COMMISSION ON SALARIES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR PRO-TEM AND CITY COUNCILMEMBERS

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.02 of the Longview Municipal Code creates a commission known as the Longview Citizens' Commission on Salaries for Elected Officials; and

WHEREAS, the purpose and duties of the commission shall be to meet not less often than once during each even-numbered year, prior to the first day of June of such year, to study the relationship of salaries to the duties of members of the Longview city council and the mayor of the city of Longview, and fix the salaries for each respective position; and

WHEREAS, the Commission conducted a meeting on February 13, 2018, at which it considered the duties and responsibilities of the mayor, mayor pro-tem and councilmembers, as well as the salaries of elected officials of other similarly sized cities in Washington; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2018 the Commission conducted a public hearing on proposed salary increases, following which the Commission voted to approve said increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Citizens' Commission on Salaries for Elected Officials as follows:

Section 1. The salaries of the Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem and Councilmembers of the City of Longview, shall be as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and by this reference made a part thereof, and shall be effective 30 days the official filing date.
