 - -TAXIWAYS ARE TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED FOR 2018

TENANT RECORDS AND CONTRACTS HAVE BEEN UPDATED

THE ANNUAL REVENUE INCREASE FOR EXISTING CONTRACTS FOR A TWELVE MONTH PERIOD ENDING FEBRUARY 2018 COMPARED TO FEBRUARY 2017 IS 4.2% OR \$5,800 ANNUALLY.

→ SEVERAL NEW CONTRACTS IN 2017

THE TOTAL REVENUE INCREASE FROM EXISTING CONTRACTS <u>AND</u> NEW DEVELOPMENT (LAND LEASE) CONTRACTS FOR A TWELVE MONTH PERIOD ENDING FEBRUARY 2018 COMPARED TO FEBRUARY 2017 IS 8.4% OR \$11,800 ANNUALLY.

AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT

- CREATED AN AIRPORT STRATEGIC PLAN
 - -STRATEGIC PLANNING TEAM MADE UP OF AIRPORT TENANT AND COMMUNITY LEADERS
 - -NEW FACILITY AND INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE PLAN
 - -KEY PROJECTS SCHEDULED OVER NEXT 3-5 YEARS
 - -FINANCIAL FORECASTING
- WE ARE IN THE MIDST OF OUR AIRPORT MASTER PLAN AND WILDLIFE HAZARD MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE.
- SUPPORT EAST AND WEST SIDE DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES
 - -THREE HANGAR DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES ARE CURRENTLY BEING EVALUATED.
- SECURED \$1 MILLION GRANT FOR RUNWAY REPAIRS


