- Vandalism costs of \$1558 for this period
- Vandalism at Archie, Lake Sacajawea and John Null
- Collected 18 sharps this period
- Cleaned 1 area of park camper debris
- Archie 2-5 slide destroyed
- Car drove through fence at John Null, plant material pulled out and poles replaced
- Completed annual inventory of all storage and equipment
- Signage, mutt mitt dispensers and garbage can installed along golf course dike trail
- Constructed and installed additional walkway panels at Asian island
- Snow storm required ice removal
- Parks crew continue assisting with city wide tree elevation and sidewalk clearance
- Annual playground inspections safety issues have been repaired
- Started pre-emergent weed control
- Mole control has been placed at Parks
- Crew has attended fire extinguisher annual training

- Flagging certifications have been renewed
- Archie Anderson and Kellogg Park playground replacement plans have started
