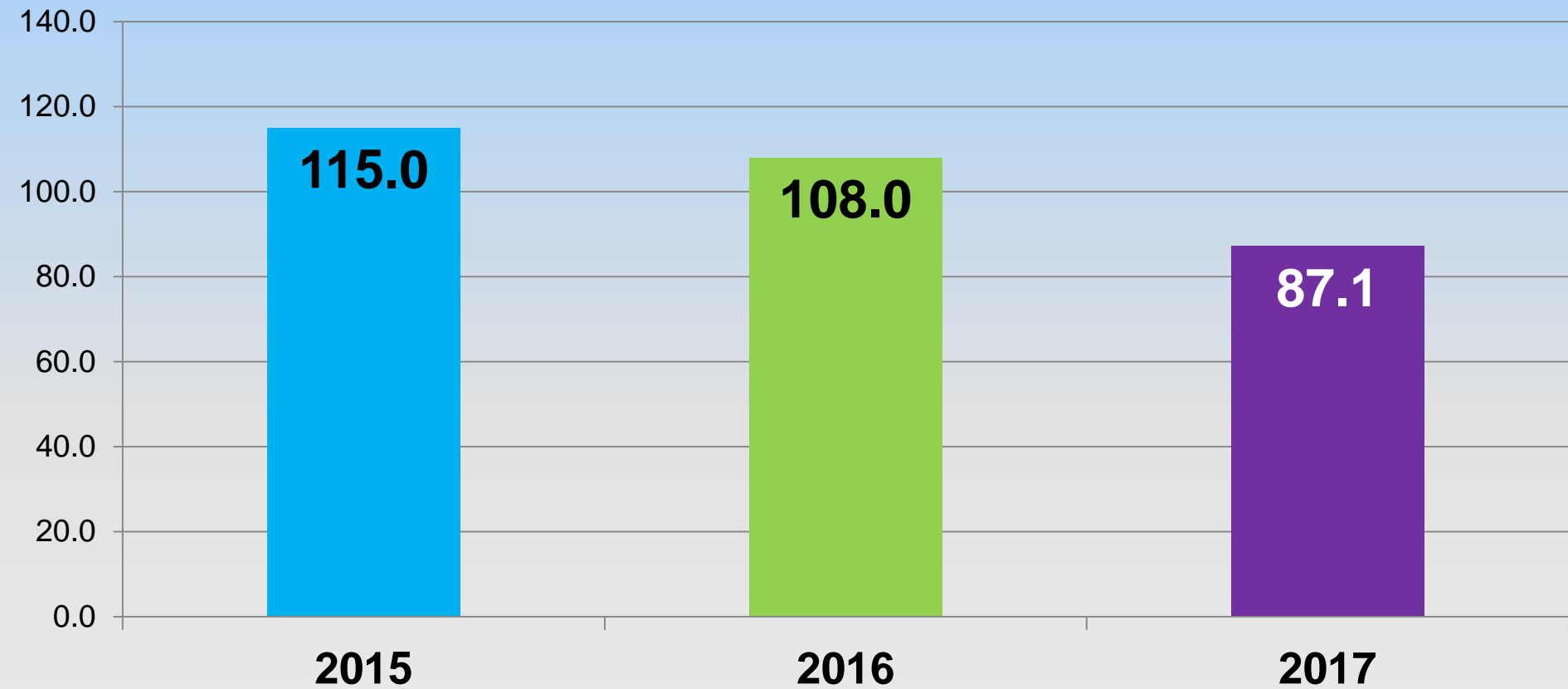

Longview Group A Offense Rate

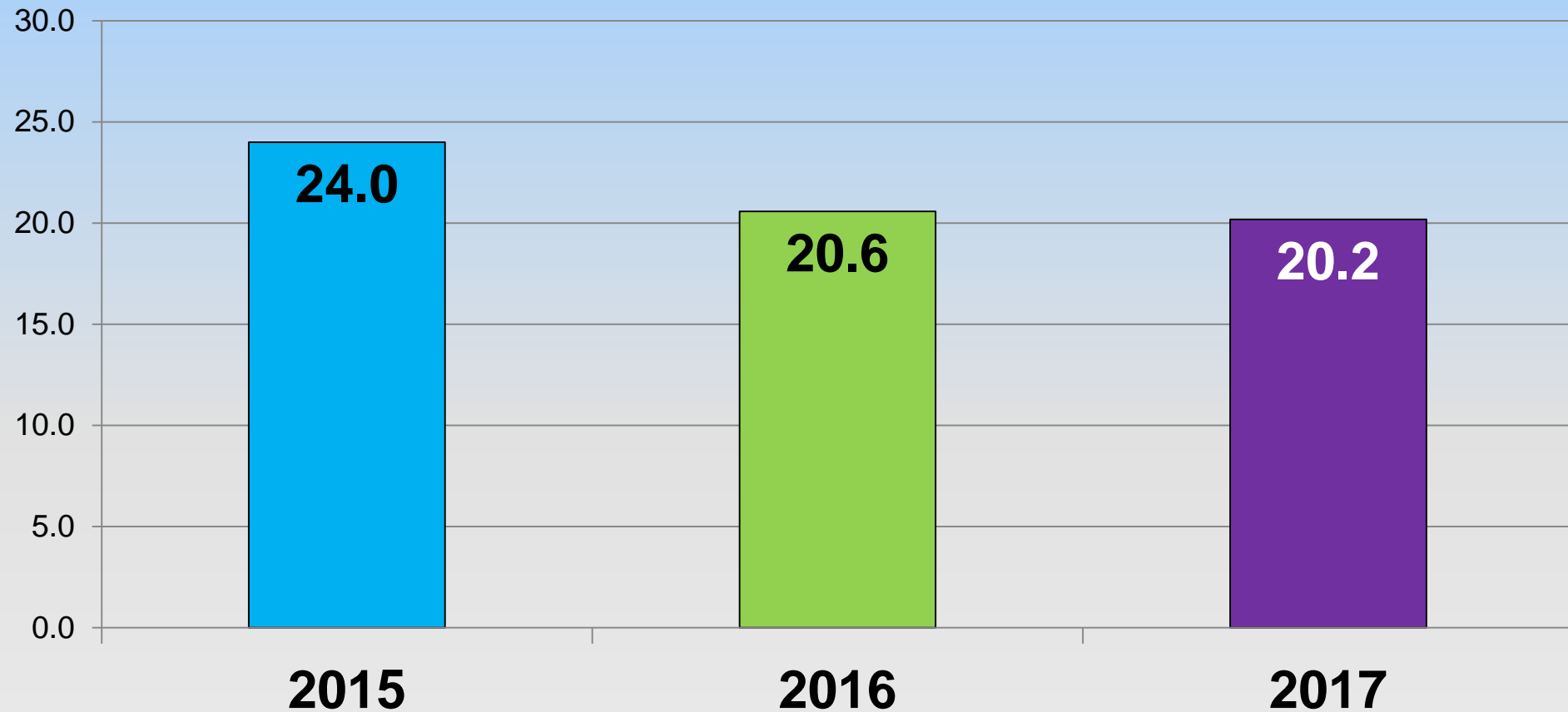


2017 Group A Offense rate is down 19% from 2016

Longview Group A *Persons* Crime Rate per 1000

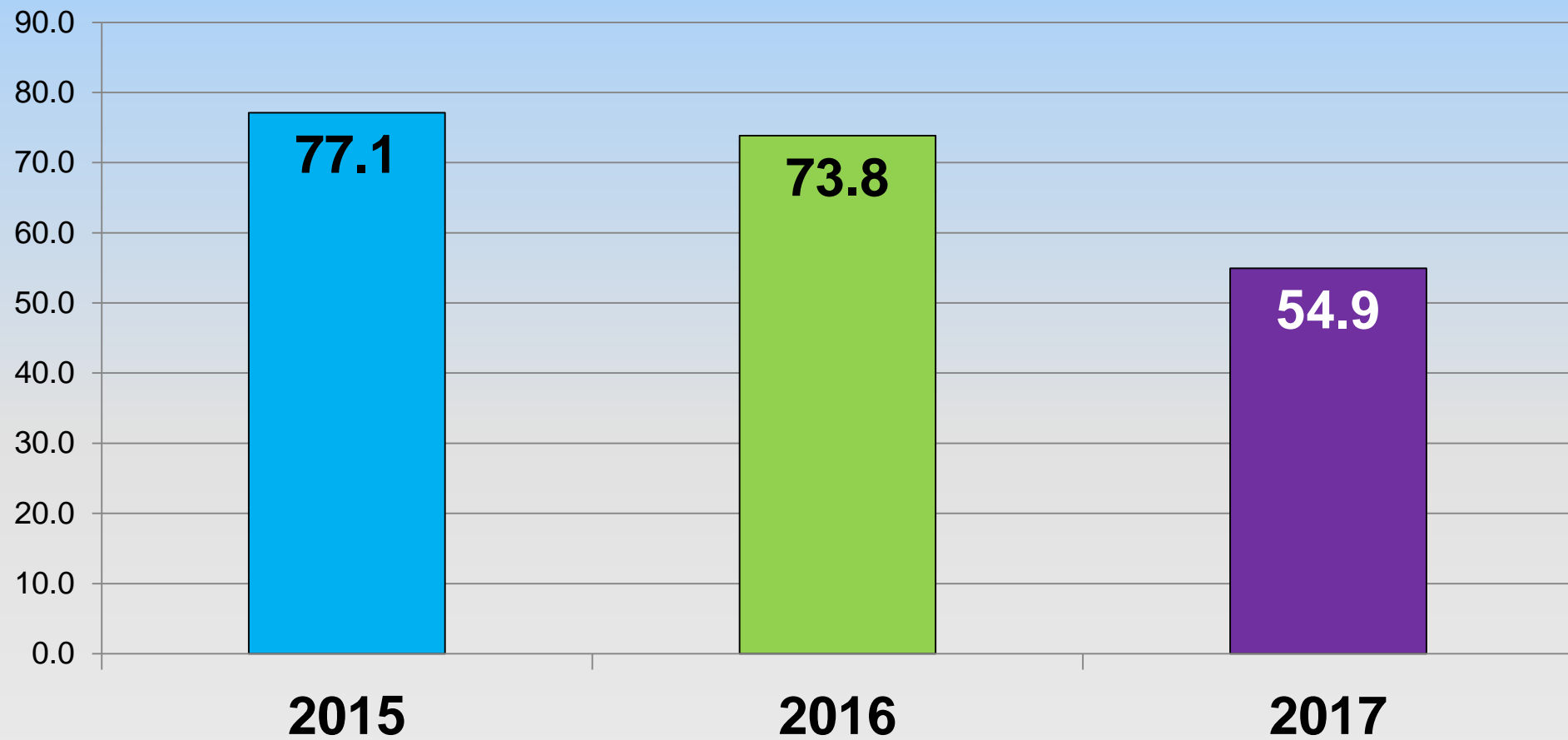


2017 Crimes against Persons rate is down 2% from 2016

Longview Group A *Property* Crime Rate per 1000 population

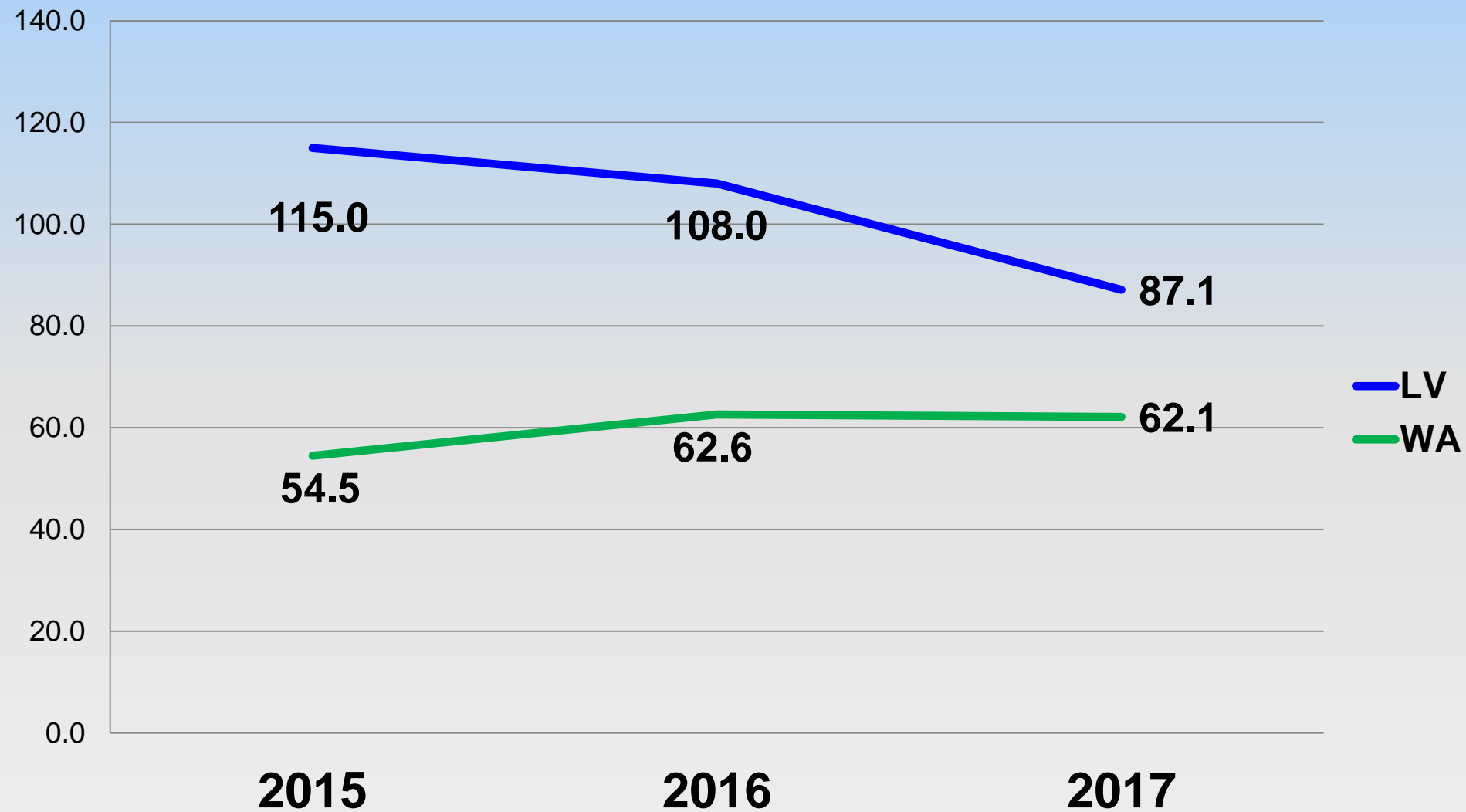

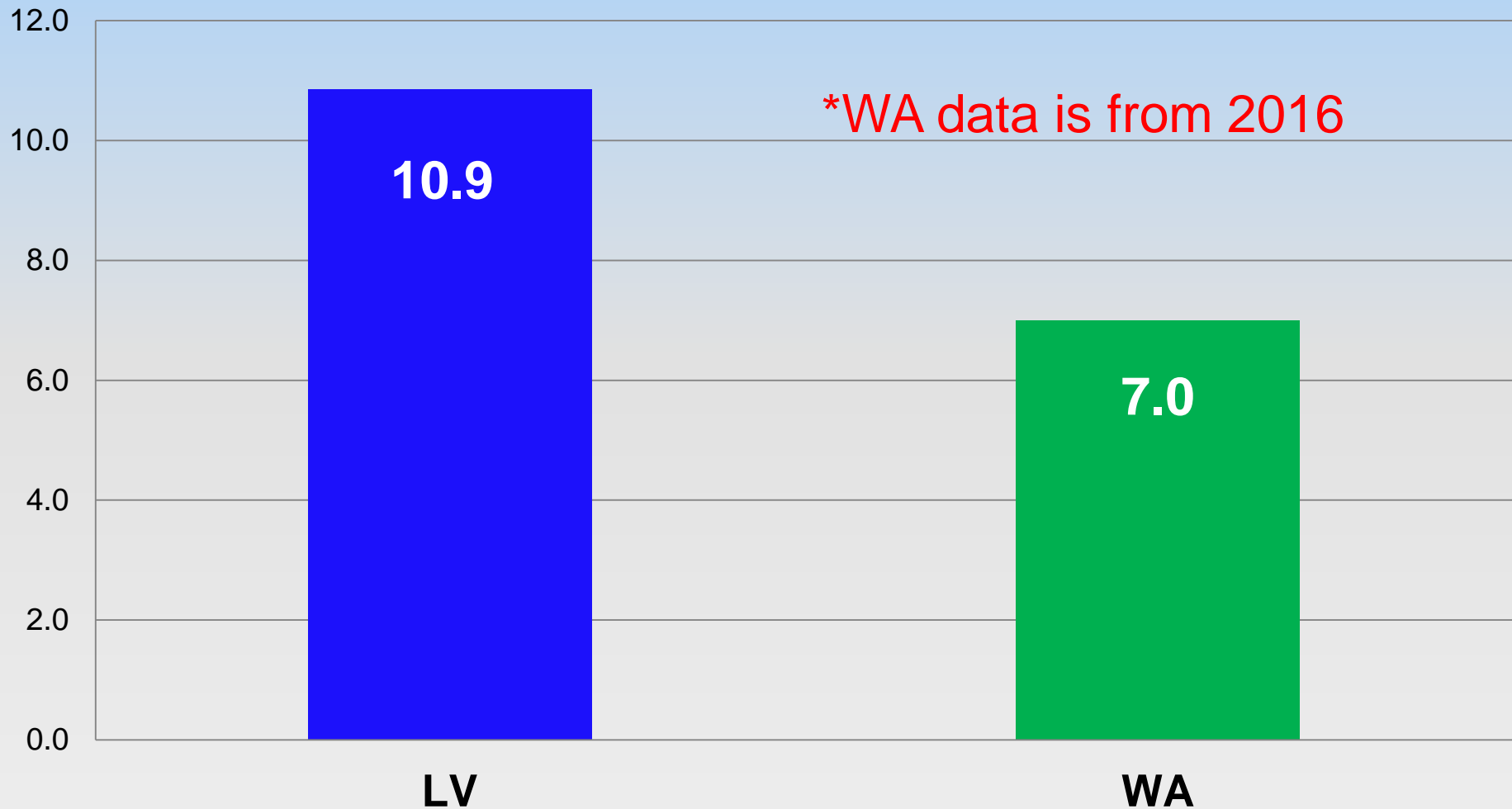
LV vs WA Group A Crime Rate per 1000 population

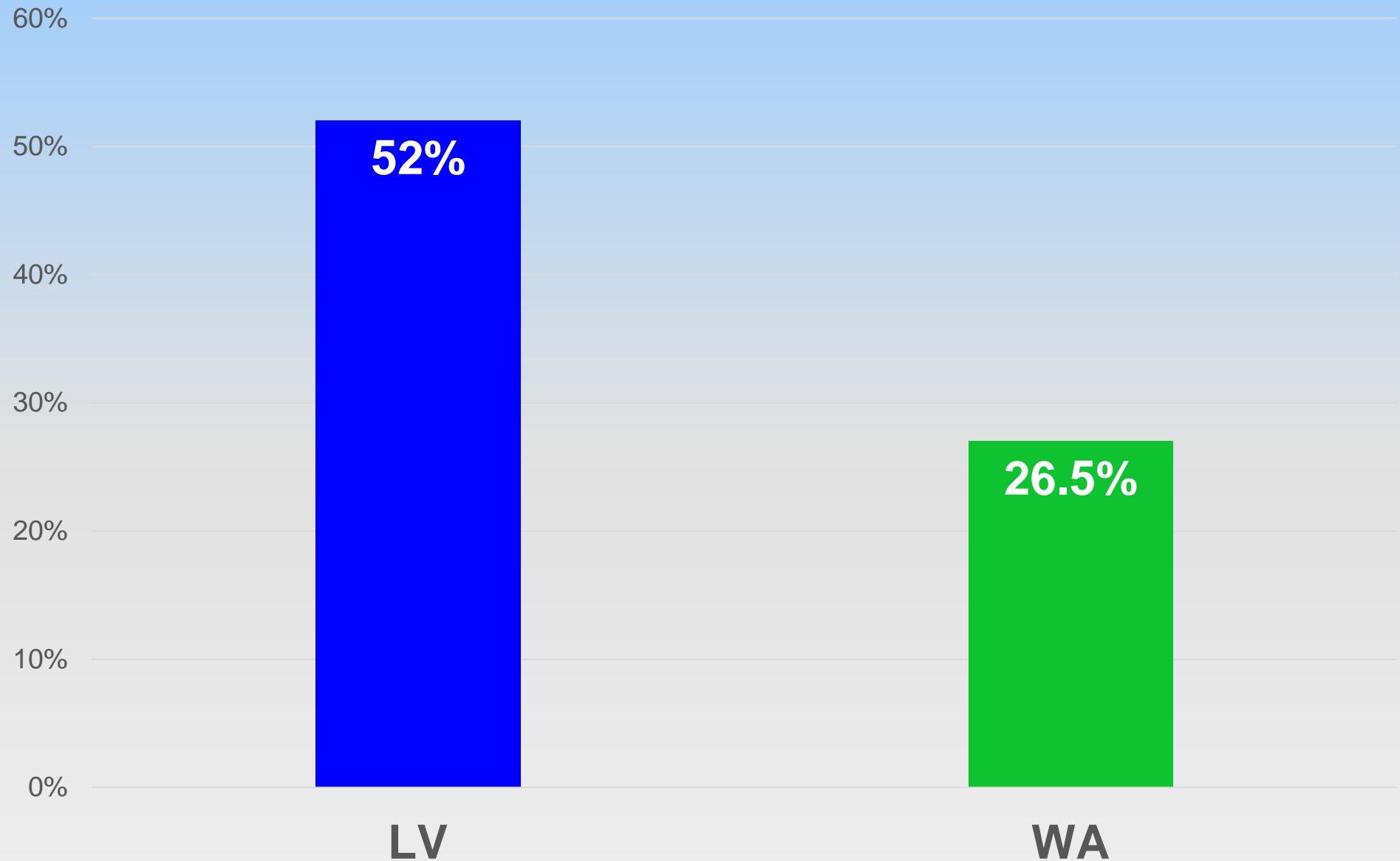
Domestic Violence Rates per 1000 population

CIU will have a dedicated DV detective in 2018



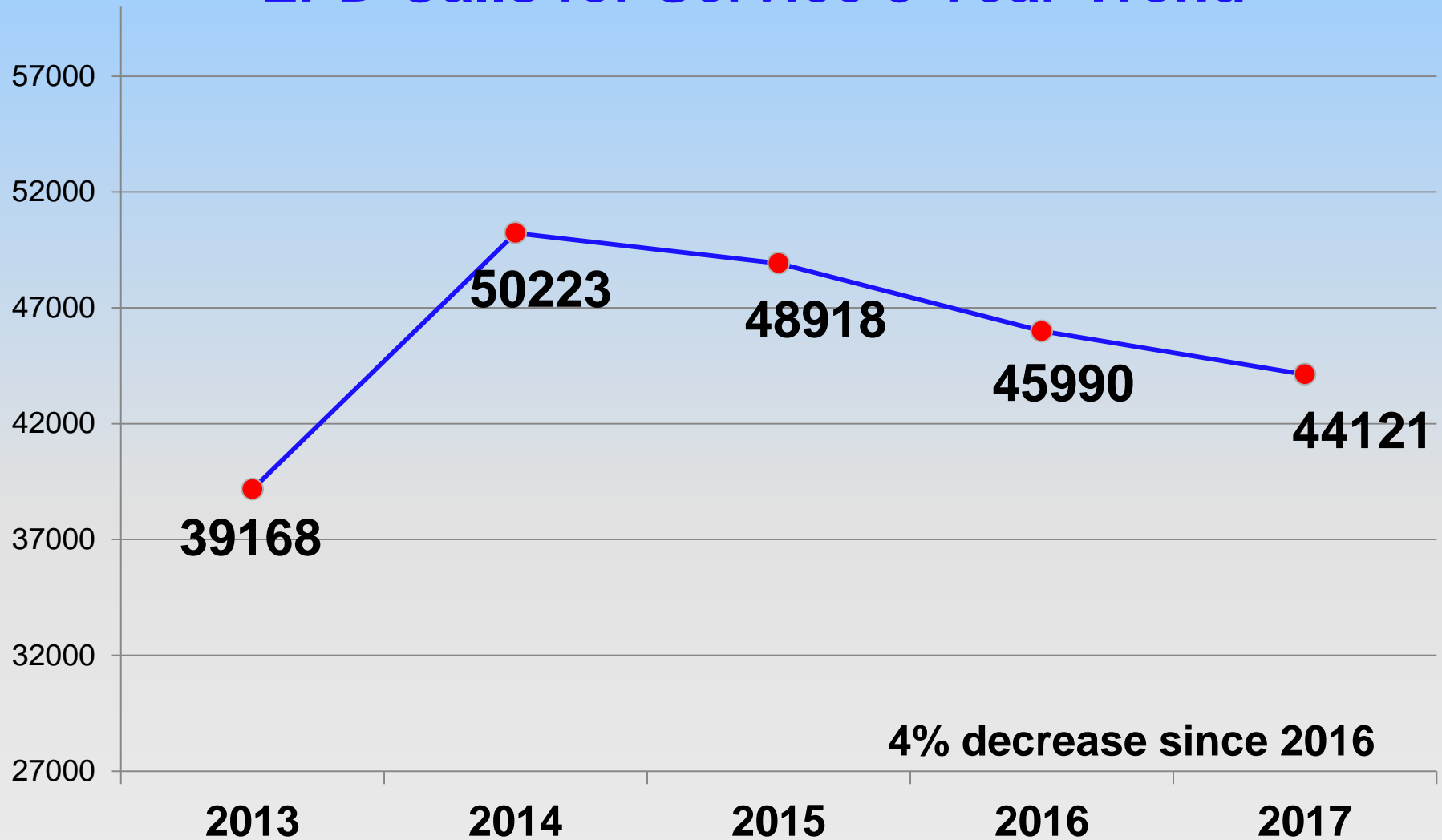
2017 Clearance Rates

LPD Calls for Service 5 Year Trend



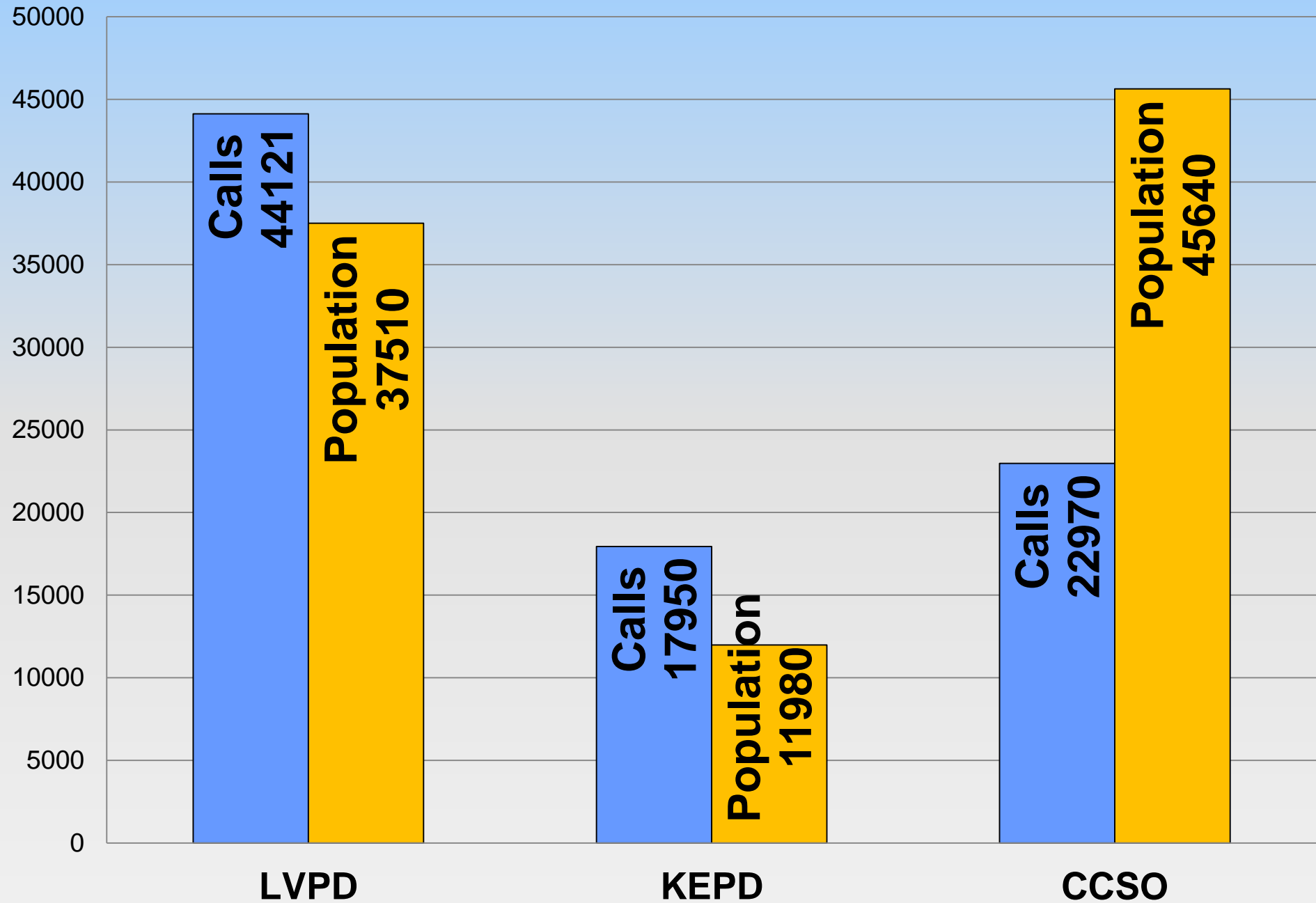

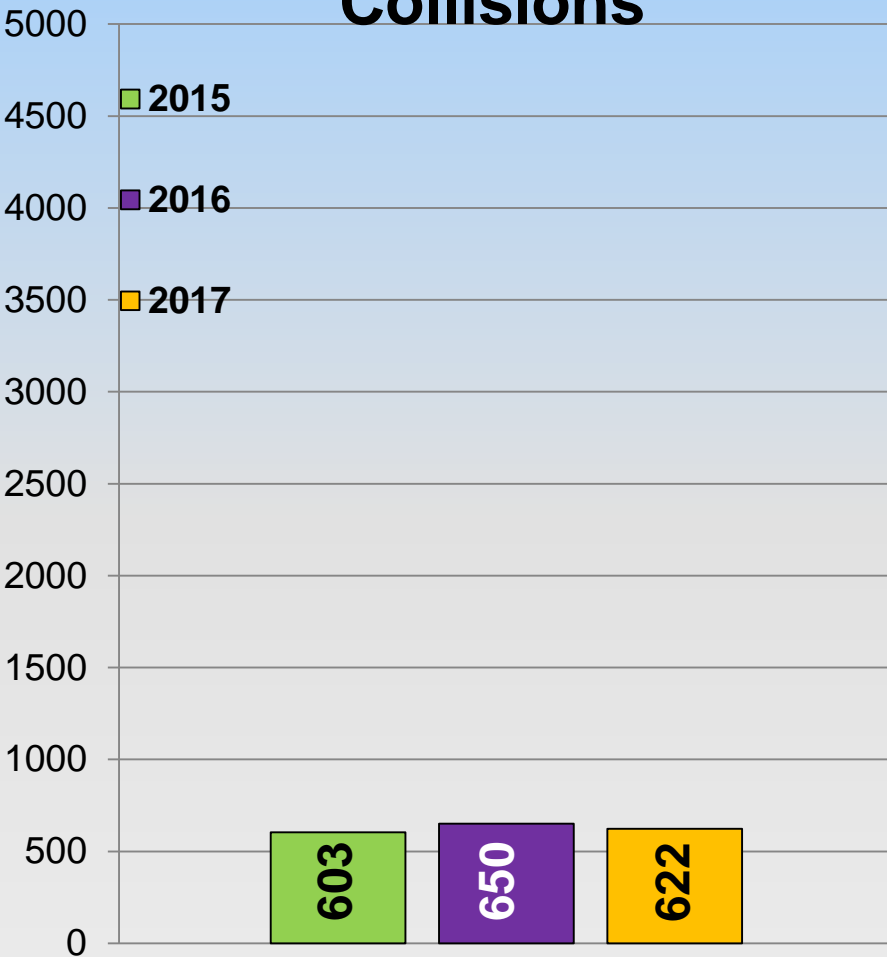

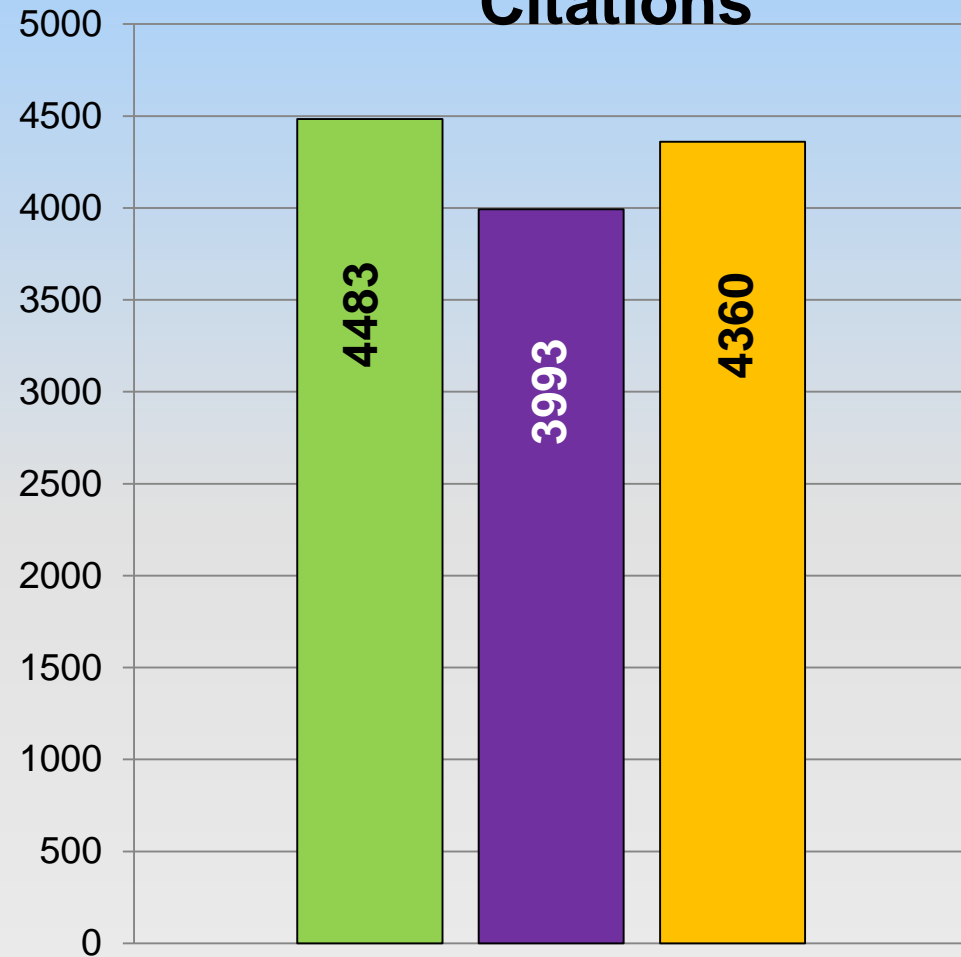


Traffic Statistics
