

ORDINANCE NO. 21

An ordinance granting to Cowlitz County for the benefit of Consolidated Diking Improvement District No. 1 of said County and to the Supervisors of said District a franchise to construct and maintain a drainage ditch in that portion of 26th Ave. in Highlands Addition to Longview No. 1, lying South of the Northerly line of Beech St.

The City Council of the City of Longview do ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby granted to Cowlitz County for the benefit of Consolidated Diking Improvement District No. 1 of said County and to the Supervisors of said District the right, privilege and franchise to construct and maintain a drainage ditch in that portion of 26th Ave. in Highlands Addition to Longview, No. 1, lying South of the Northerly line of Beech Street, said ditch to constitute and be maintained as a part of the general drainage system of said district; provided, that said ditch shall be so constructed, maintained and used as not unduly to interfere with the use of said 26th Ave. as a public thoroughfare.

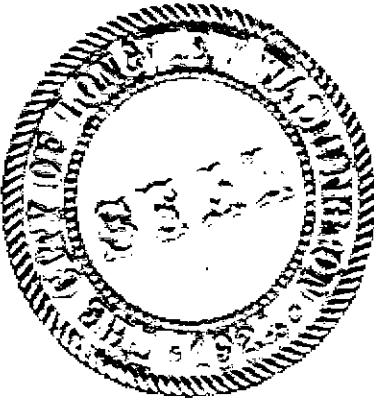
