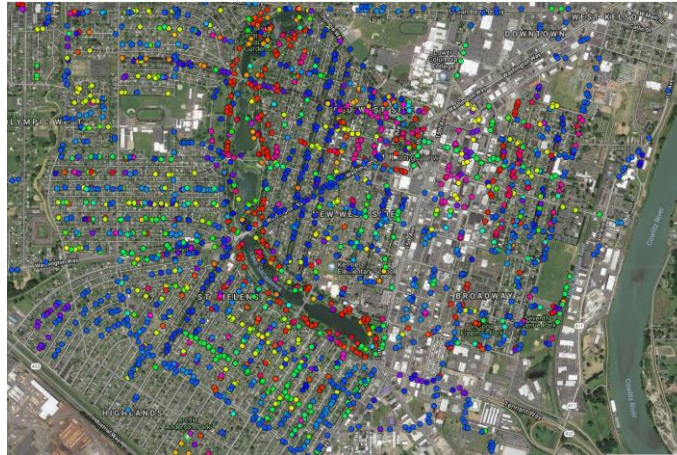

- Sprayed 765 trees for fruit control
- Tree inventory update very near complete
- Completed our Arbor Day Tree Planting

PARKS BOARD REPORT

- Top dressed and over seeded areas damaged due to wet weather driving
- Have completed edging and weed whipping of all areas
- Aeration complete
- Mowing routes continue
- Vacuumed heavy cutting areas
- Vandalism costs of \$1839 for this period
- 4 playgrounds have been top dressed with cushioning material
- Repaired vandalized drinking fountain at Hemlock
- Replaced locking mechanism on door at 17th and Nichols, Hemlock and John Null rest rooms
- Lake path has received gravel touch ups
- Repaired damage to Perennial Garden fence
- Rough mowed Mint Farm, 3rd Ave, Regency and the Nursery
- Uncovered and built softball fields at Roy Morse
- Started softball field preparation for spring leagues
- Pressure washed playgrounds, sidewalks, signage and infrastructure in parks
- 11 Homeless camps removed and clean up
- 47 Sharps collected this period
- This period 33 sharps have been collected
- Repaired parking lot lights at Gerhart
- Repeat vandalism to magnetic locks at Hemlock and 17th rest rooms
- Plumbing damaged at 17th and Nichols
- Spring Pre and post weed control is complete
- Most irrigation has been started and checked for season
- Hanging baskets installed at Hemlock walk and City Hall
- Delivered mulch to downtown parking lots
- Pressure washed garbage cans, tables and playgrounds
