## PARKS BOARD REPORT

- Were able to schedule mow and leaf mulch route in December with nice weather
- Leaf mulching and cleanup has been completed in shrub beds and flower areas
- Vandalism costs of \$9282 for this period
- Slide at Hoehne Park replaced
- Slide at Rotary replaced with climbing ladder
- Vandalism to electrical boxes and magnetic locks at 17<sup>th</sup> and Nichols shelter and RR's
- Fence at Perennial Gardens pulled out of ground
- Sewer department assisted with unplugging Elks RR's
- Installed at RA Long Park, Lions Island, Squirrel Bridge and Downtown
- Assisted with Christmas parade and lighting ceremony
- Top dressed and planted grass seed over areas damaged from Park driving
- Pressure washing playgrounds and other infrastructure has started
- Started moss control on sidewalks, pathways and roofs
- Mole activity is heavy and control is underway
- Annual playground safety inspections are complete
- Added gravel to Lake path system
- Drain at Hemlock Plaza cleaned and now working properly
- Large area mowers are all scheduled for winter inspections and repair for spring start up
- Rest room cleaning continues 7 days a week
- Obtained trapping permit for beaver at Mint Valley Golf Course
