## Grant Information

$\square 3$ year project
$\square$ Up to $\$ 500,000$ for projects with population up to 400,000
$\square$ Must partner with a victim services agency \& government agency (MOU required).
$\square$ City of Longview must be the lead applicant.
$\square$ No match is required
$\square$ Application is due 2/26/19
$\square$ Allowable costs - salary, benefits, officer overtime, training, supplies, equipment, travel.
$\square$ Program must address one or more of the 22 purposes areas outlined in the grant announcement.
$\square$ Unallowable costs - uniforms, vehicles and weapons

## Longview Police Departments proposal

$\square$ Address purpose area 1 (to implement pro-arrest programs and policies in police departments, including policies for protection order violations and enforcement of protection orders across state and tribal lines).
$\square$ Address purpose area 14 (to develop and implement training programs for prosecutors and other prosecution related personnel regarding best practices to ensure offender accountability, victim safety and victim consultation in cases involving domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking, including the appropriate treatment of victims.
$\square$ Increase staffing by 1 police detective position to focus on domestic violence investigations as well as enforcement of protection orders.
$\square$ Partner with the Emergency Support Shelter for increased victim advocacy services.
$\square$ Provide required training to all partners (Police Department, City Attorney's office and ESS).
