Mr. Langdon reviewed the staff report.

Chairman Collins opened the public hearing. Hearing no speakers, Chairman Collins closed the public hearing.

He noted that there is currently conflicting language in the code regarding ambulance services and public safety facilities. He proposes returning the draft amendment to staff to address the language.

A motion was made by Mr. Bob Beal, seconded by Mr. Ray Van Tongeren, that this matter be referred back to planning staff to develop draft code language addressing ambulance services as well as public safety buildings. The motion passed unanimously.

6. NON-PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

Zoning for Pacific Fibre Products Annexation request

A motion was made by Ms. Sharyl Whitmire, seconded by Mr. Thomas Warren, that a public hearing be set for the May 7, 2014 regular meeting on zoning for lands proposed to be annexed providing that no one invokes the jurisdiction of the Cowlitz County Boundary Review Board. The motion carried unanimously.

Zoning text amendment for Industrial Districts regarding the size of athletic facilities

A request for a zoning text amendment is asking for the 10,000 sq. ft. or larger requirement for a sports facility be eliminated. Staff will draft the language for a public hearing May 7, 2014.

A motion was made by Mr. Donald Maloney, seconded by Mr. Ray Van Tongeren, that this matter be scheduled for a public hearing on May 7, 2014. The motion carried unanimously.

7. OTHER BUSINESS

8. PLANNER'S REPORT

Marijuana: Nothing has passed in the Legislature to reconcile medical/recrational marijuana. There will be a lottery for recreation stores. 20-50% of the returned

application packets are incomplete. The State hopes to begin issuing licenses before July.
