- * The Village at Mt. Solo is planning a 14 lot subdivision. There will be 7-9 months of pre-loading.
- * Pacific Coast Fertilizer is working on impact statements and there will be a public hearing in the fall.
- * A revised application for the last area at Overlook will be submitted this summer.
- * An annexation proposal for an area of west Longview is being prepared.

Public Works:

- * The LID is proceeding for Beech St.
- * Current projects include water/sewer lines, pump stations
- * The RA Long Park Plaza and Gazebo project will go out to bid soon.
- * Consultant selection for the off/on ramps at 3rd Ave and for the California Way intersection projects.
