Otak has been chosen as the project manager. A bid opening was held and JH Kelly is the apparent low. Council will award the bid at the next Council meeting.

10. Grant Funding Updates

We were not successful for the grant for 4 buses submitted in August. Asher will research if federal dollars can be used to purchase the buses.

Asher submitted a grant proposal for 3 small buses and operating expenses. It is a competitive grant. Asher will present to the RTPO at the COG next week. Competitors for the grant will be ranked and awards will be announced Spring 2019.

11. Manager's Report

Prompted by a question from Jensen, Asher explained that in the past busses we are phasing out have gone to auction. Now, we are looking for ways to share those resources.

The Transit Department has seen a lot of staff movement recently. Tabitha Hayden was promoted to a supervisor. We have hired three new transit drivers. We have ads out for a Dispatcher position, and the Administrative Assistant position. Our CTA Audit came back clean.
