**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

The project includes construction of streetscape improvements including sidewalk and ADA ramps, bio-filtration planters and stormwater facilities, paving, and trees and landscaping improvements. The improvements will be made on Tennant Way from 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

On April 15, 2015, five bids were received as follows:

- \$1,870,447.14 - Sterling Breen Crushing, Inc., Chehalis, WA
- \$1,987,800.10 - 3 Kings Environmental, Inc., Battle Ground, WA
- \$2,085,900.00 - Advanced Excavating Specialists LLC, Longview, WA
- \$2,183,398.20 - Five Rivers Construction, Inc., Longview, WA
- \$2,200,890.56 - Olivas Valdez, Inc., LaCenter, WA

**\$2,300,000.00 - Engineer's Estimate**

All bids received were determined to be regular and responsive.
