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### **BID REVIEW - 2015 WATERLINE REPLACEMENT - ST. HELENS NO. 1**

#### **COUNCIL STRATEGIC INITIATIVE ADDRESSED:**

Provide sustainable water quality & environmental infrastructure

#### **SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

This project will replace existing deteriorated 6-inch cast iron water main with approximately 2,500 feet of 8-inch and 350 feet of 6-inch ductile iron pipe, reconnect 81 water services, and install 4 new fire hydrants. The work will occur in the 500 and 600 blocks of the alley between 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 16<sup>th</sup> Ave., and in the 600 block of the alley between Oregon Way and 15<sup>th</sup> Ave.
